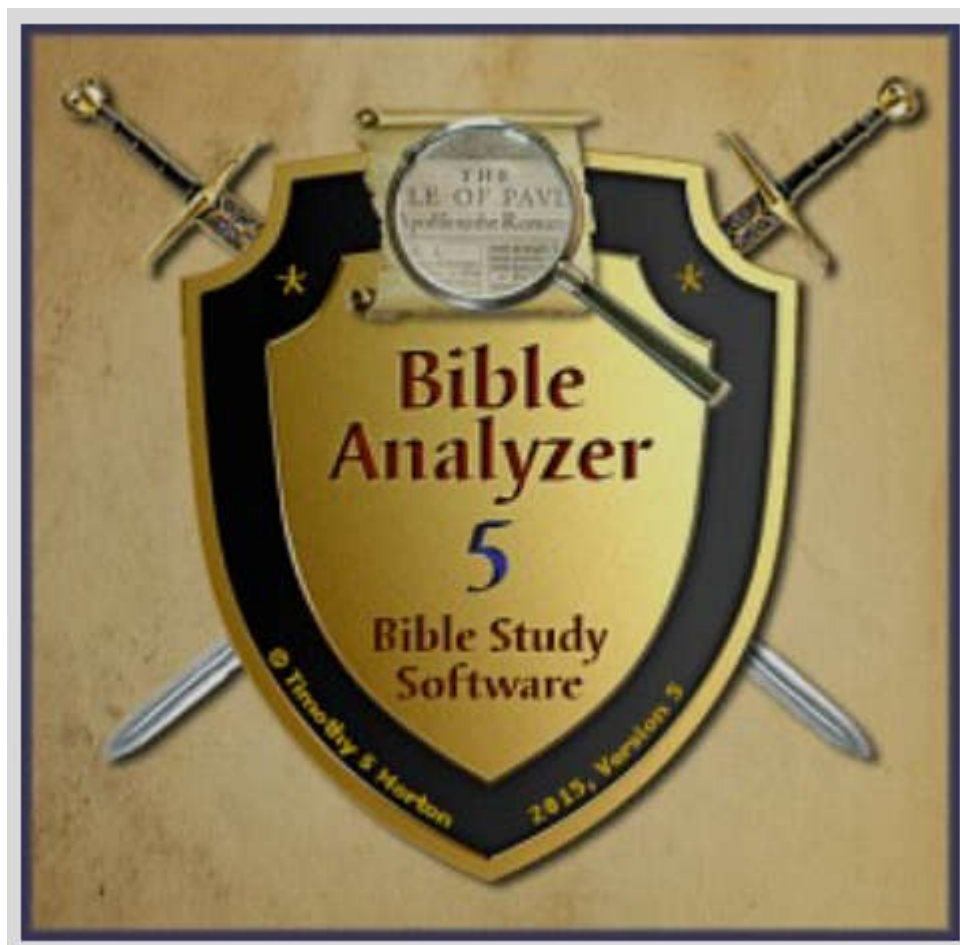




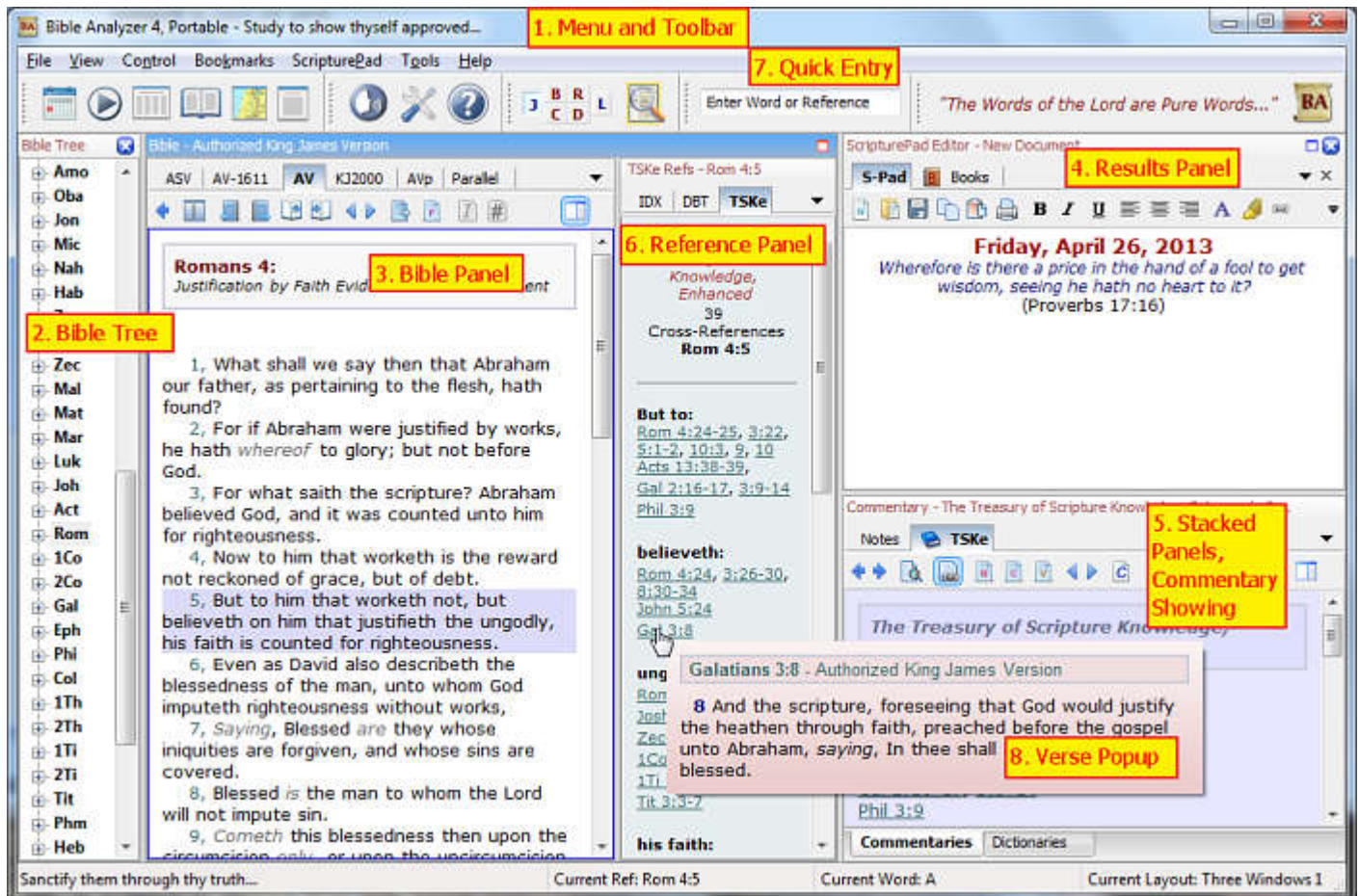

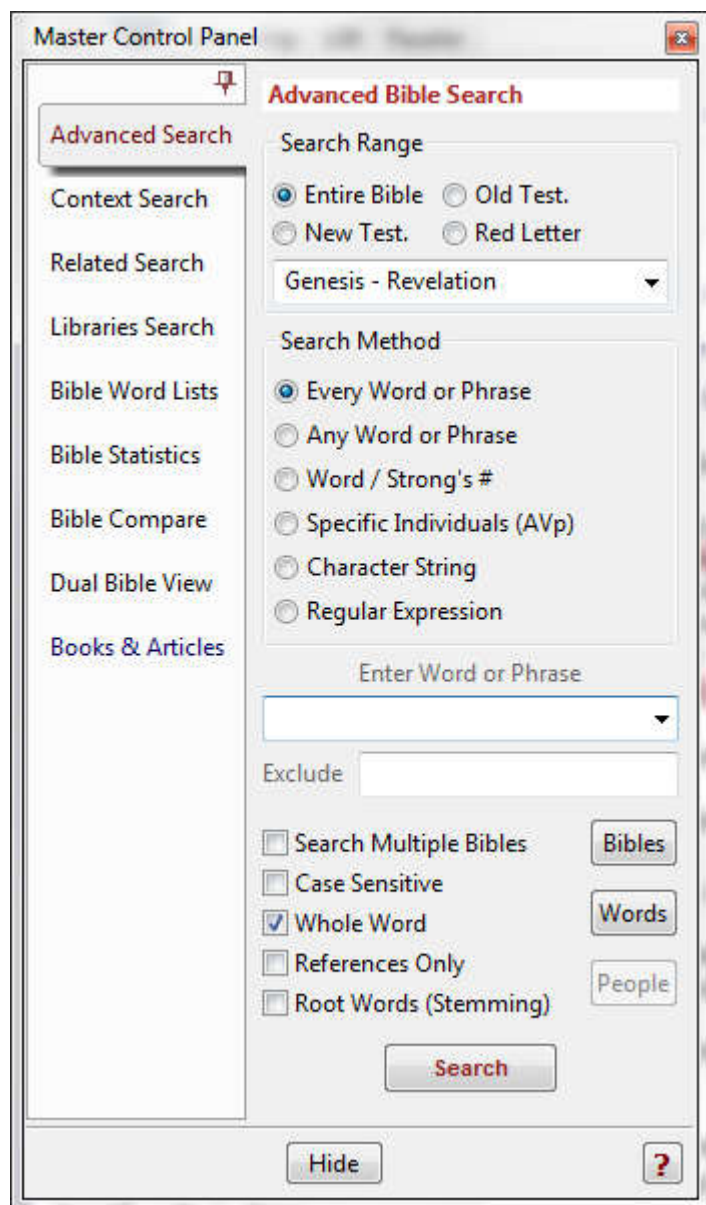

Bible Analyzer was designed to be simple to use and easy to navigate. Below is an overview of some of **Bible Analyzer's** major components in its main window:

Note:

Most screen shots in this help file are of the *Microsoft Windows 7* Edition. The *Linux/Ubuntu* version has slightly different appearance, however the functionality of **Bible Analyzer** is much the same.





1. The Menubar and Toolbar

The Icons on the Toolbars are as follows starting from the left:

The left side of the Message Toolbar area also contains a place for customizable text. (See [Customize](#)).

2. The Bible Tree

To select a Bible chapter to display, select it from the [Bible Tree](#)

3. The Bible Panel

Bible chapters selected from the Bible Tree display in the **Bible Panel**. It contains all loaded Bible Modules. To view a different Bible text Click, the appropriate tab near the top. Also, the **Dedicated Cross-Reference Panel** is within the [Bible Panel](#).

4. The Results Panel

Along with [ScripturePad](#) and the [Books Display](#), most user initiated actions, such as *search results*, *comparison results*, *statistic results*, etc., display in the **Results Panel**.

5. The Commentary and Dictionary Panel Stacked

These panel are by default stacked for efficient use of space. They can be separated into separate panels by selecting an option under the Layout button.

All loaded commentary modules display in the **Commentary Panel**. To view a different commentary text, Click the appropriate tab near the top.

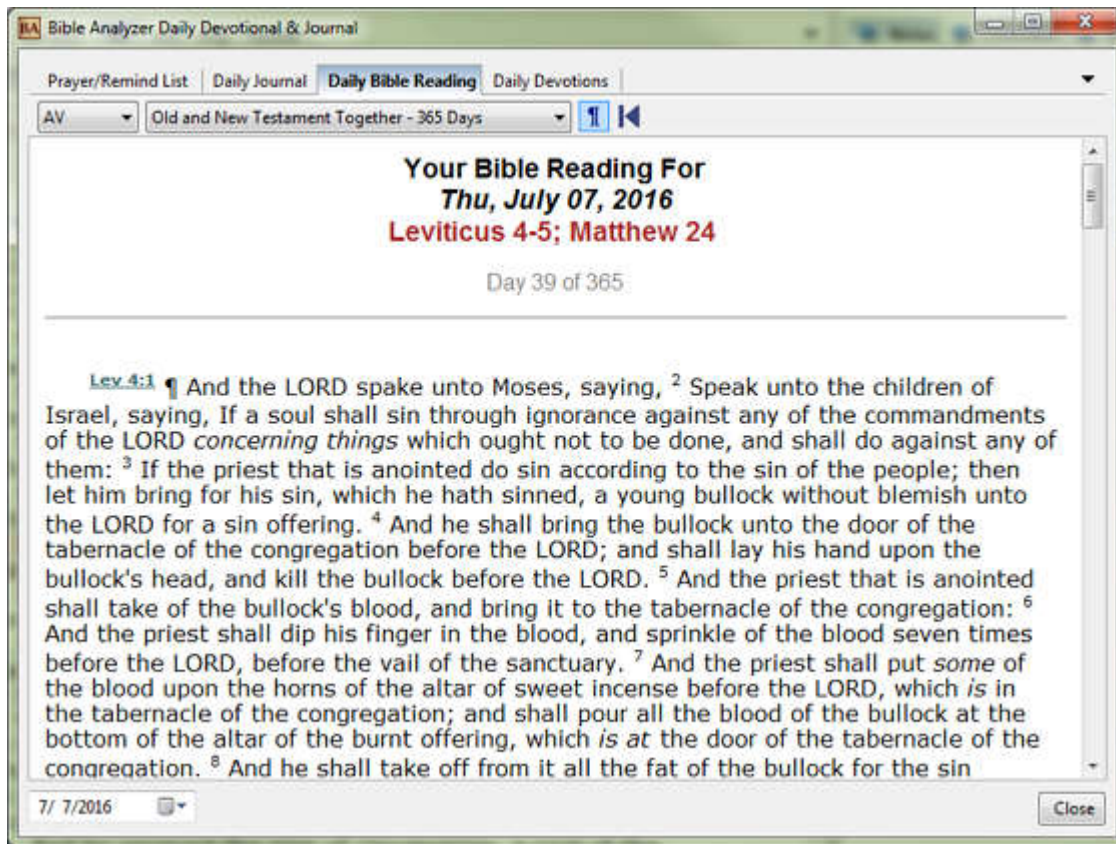
The **Dictionary Panel** contains all loaded dictionary Modules. To view a different dictionary text, Click the appropriate tab near the top.

6. The Reference Panel



To open the **Daily Devotions Viewer**, click the Toolbar Icon or press **F9**

The Viewer contains four tabs with various daily features.

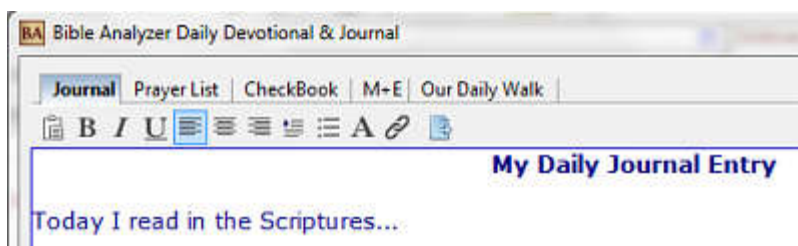


Prayer List

The first tab in the **Daily Devotions Viewer** is an **Prayer List Editor**. The list editor will automatically open and save to file *prayer.xml* in the Users folder when the **Daily Devotions Viewer** is opened/closed. The editor has many of the same editing features as **ScripturePad** and the **Notes Editor**.

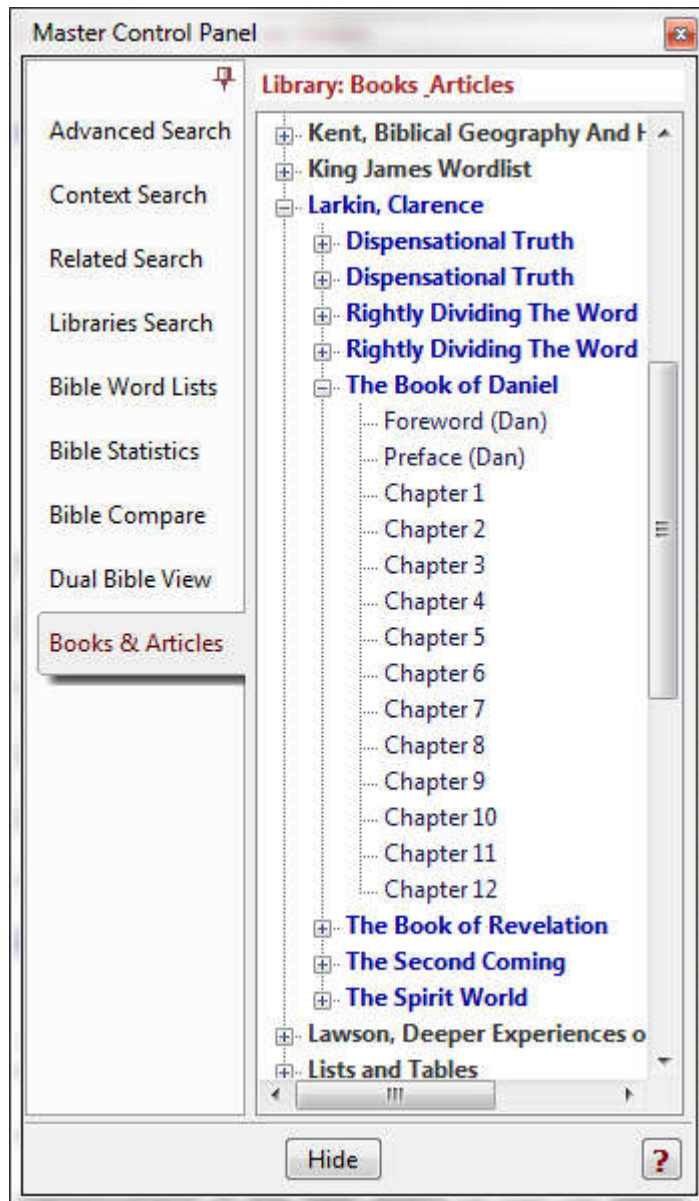
Daily Journal

The second tab is the **Journal**. The Journal is linked to the current day which can be changed with the Calendar control at the bottom left corner. Common formatting tools are available in the toolbar plus an Export Button which will export all Journal entries, along with the day, to an RTF file.

The ninth Tab on the **Master Control Panel** is the **Book/Article Viewer**



The **Book/Article Viewer** displays slightly modified *HTML* files placed in the proper SQLite database format (.bk extension). See [Module Creation Tools](#) for details on how to create them.

Viewing Texts

To open the **Book Titles List** click the Toolbar Button or press **F3**. The List is under a Tab in the **Master Control Panel**. To view a text select a chapter under the Title. Single chapter book have a *Contents* chapter.

By default the Book Text will display under a dedicated **Books Tab** (the second tab) in the **Results Display**.

Tip:

By changing the option in [Preferences](#), the text can alternatively be displayed in a *stand-alone window*. If a text contain links to images (i.e. *Dispensational Truth*), click the **Back Button** (arrow) on the Toolbar to return to the page from an image.

Searching Texts

Book/Article Texts can be searched as with Commentaries and Dictionaries. See the [Library Search](#) Tab in [Master Control Panel](#) for details.

The ***Bible Analyzer Suite CD-Rom*** contains a multitude of valuable texts that total many thousands of pages. To view a resource simply select the book name from the top ***Book List***, and if the ***Title*** contains chapters, they will display in the ***Chapter List***.

Making Custom Library Texts - See [Module Creation Tools](#)

Incorporated into **Bible Analyzer** is an independent **Image Viewer**. When opened the viewer will be in a separate *Window Frame* from the main application.

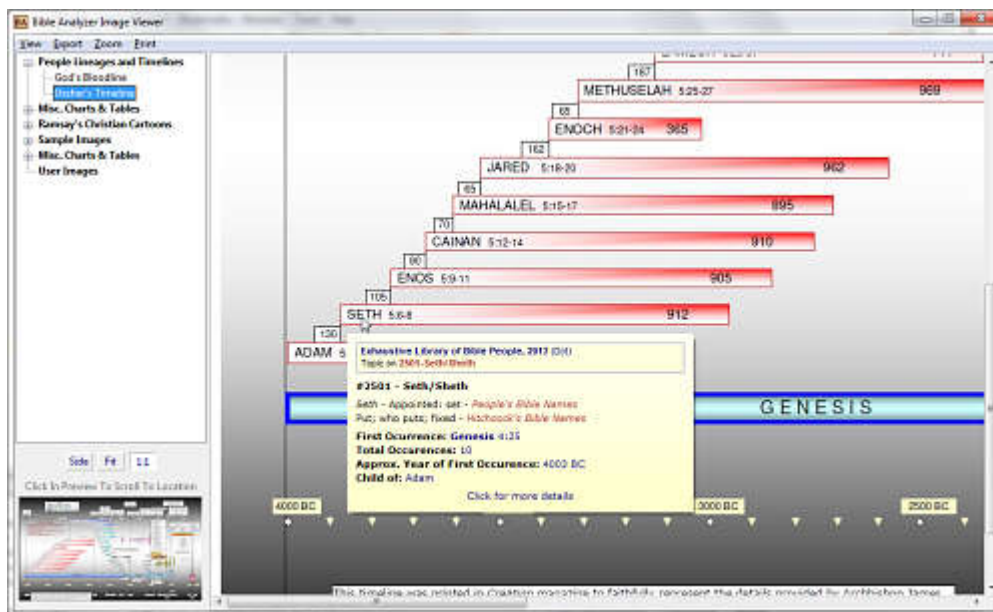
To open the **Bible Analyzer Image Viewer** either:

- Click the **Image Icon** in the **Toolbar**, or
- Click **Image Viewer** under the **Control Menu**
- Hit **F4** on the keyboard

Once opened the **Image Viewer** will display on the left a Tree listing all the loaded image modules. Each Image group can be expanded to show all the available images.

Hint:

The Tree can be hidden and shown by selecting **Hide/Show Image Tree** from the View Menu.



The **Side** button will cause the image to be re-sized to the shortest side making scrolling only on one side necessary.

The **Fit** button will down-size the image to fit entirely in the display. **Fit** will not up-size images.

The **1:1** Button will restore the image to actual size.

The **Thumbnail Preview** shows a small preview of the entire image. Clicking in the preview will cause the image display on the right to scroll to that position.

Interactive Images

Beginning with version 4.1, the **Image Viewer** can display verse and search popups from specially mapped images and also cause the main Bible Analyzer Window to display the results on left mouse click.

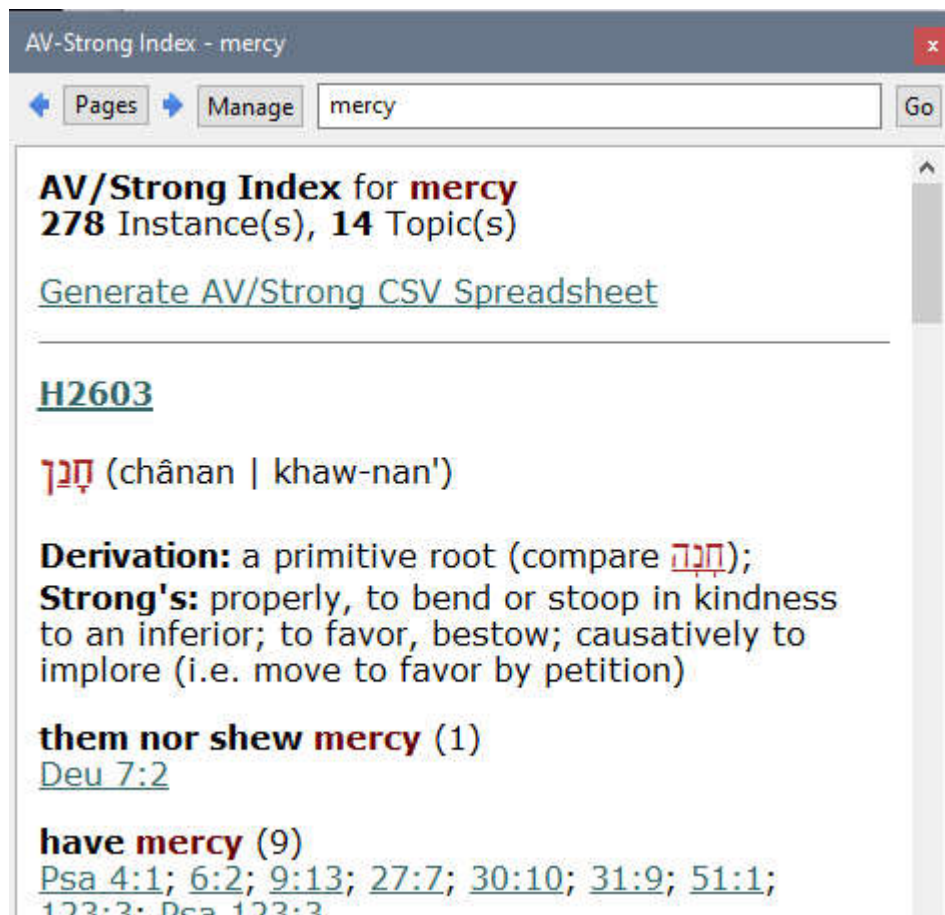
Hint:

Exporting and printing of images is available from the **Image Viewer Menu**. The files are exported in *.png* format.

You can add your own .jpg, .png, and .gif images by placing them in the *Modules/* folder or *Modules/Image* folder. They will be found under **User Images** in the **Images Tree** upon the next start.

The **MultiWindow** is a powerful and convenient window that can display exported pages, AV-Strong Index data, and much more. The **Manage** button allows the pages to be *Merged, Copied, Searched, and Saved/Loaded*.

The **MultiWindow** can be opened by clicking the icon on the toolbar or pressing the F10 key.



AV-Strong Index

The MultiWindow displays the results of a AV-Strong word index search. When a word found in the *Authorized Version* is entered in the Entry at the top-right of the MultiWindow or selected in the Right-Click Context Menu, the MultiWindow will display every reference in which the word/phrase is found under each Strong's Hebrew/Greek (Number) topic.

Note:

The *Strong's Hebrew and Greek Dictionary w/TVM, plus AV Occurences* module must be installed before the AV-Strong Index will function. See www.BibleAnalyzer.com for more details.

For instance, if the word *grace* is entered, the display header will show:

AV-Strong Index for **grace**

170 Instance(s), **4** Topic(s)

The rest of the display will show each topic (number), the Strong's original word definition, the word or phrase the word is found in, and each reference that contains the word.

Note:

The **AV-Strong Index** display is filtered to show only the instances of the Hebrew/Greek word (Strong's Number) that contain the search word(s). If the user wishes to see the complete list of words used to translate the original word (and the references), clicking on the Strong's Number at the beginning of the section ([H2580](#) in image) will cause the complete list to display in the dictionary window.

Generate CSV File

At the top of each AV/Strong's Index display there is a link [Generate AV/Strong CSV Spreadsheet](#). When clicked a dialog will be displayed with options as in this image,

Generate CSV Spreadsheet

Generate CSV Spreadsheet - "mercy"

This utility will create a CSV spreadsheet file (which can be opened in Excel and other spreadsheet programs) based on the Strong's Numbers below. Once loaded in a spreadsheet, the CSV data can be sorted, filtered, edited, and otherwise manipulated for helpful analysis.

The first list below are the available fields for the file, the second shows every Strong's Numbers for each original word that is translated as "mercy." Numbers can be edited, added, or deleted. Click the Generate Button to build the file. It will be saved in your ~/Documents/Bible Analyzer User Modules folder.

Generate

When the *Generate Button* is clicked a CSV (Comma Separated Value) file will be generated with the selected parameters. The file will be saved in the user's *~/Documents/Bible Analyzer User Modules* folder.

Once opened with spreadsheet software (such as Excel or Libre Office Calc) the data can be sorted, filtered, edited, and otherwise manipulated. The image below reflects the settings above displayed in Calc.

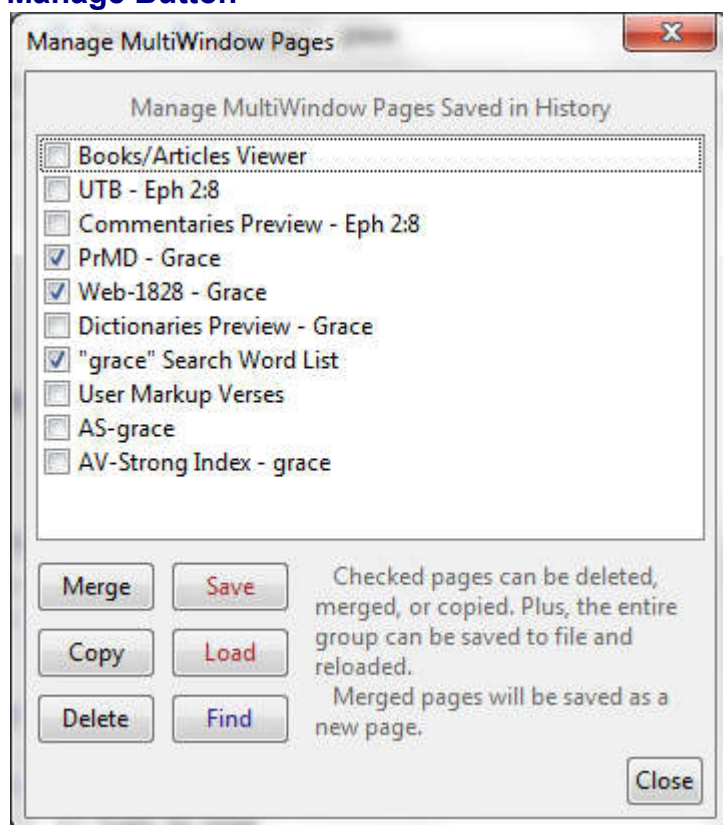
Page History

The **MultiWindow** saves all loaded/imported pages in a history. The history can be cycled by clicking the arrows or a certain page can be selected from the list generated when clicking the **Pages** button.

Hint:

The Page History make the MultiWindow very powerful for collecting pages and data for a study session. All the pages are in one convenient place for easy access allowing the other Bible Analyzer Panels to be changed.

Manage Button



The *Manage Button* open a *Pages Management Dialog* from which several actions on the *MultiWindow* pages can be performed.

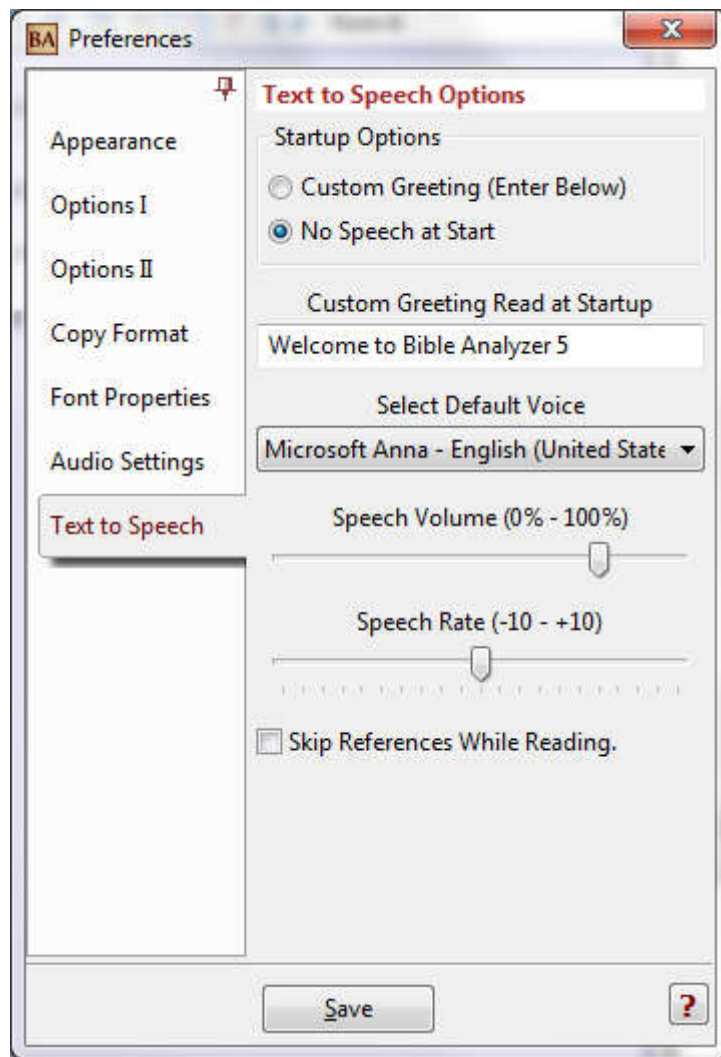
- **Merge**

Checked pages can be merged or combined together into one new page.

- **Copy**

Checked pages will be merged in memory and copied to the clipboard.

This **Tab** allows the user to manage the **Text to Speech Options**.



Startup Options

- **Custom Greeting** - speaks the text entered in the Custom Greeting Entry Box.
- **Random Verse** - speaks a random verse from the book of Proverbs.
- **No Speech** - No text is spoken.

Select Default Voice

If more than one voice is installed, this menu is used to set the default voice.

Hint:

It is recommended the user install additional voices if possible. For Windows XP *Microsoft Mary* and *Microsoft Mike* are freely available. They are considered by many more pleasing than the default *Microsoft Sam*. To our knowledge Microsoft does not offer additional voices for Windows Vista and Windows 7. However, voices can be obtained from other sources. Check the **Bible Analyzer Forum** for more information.

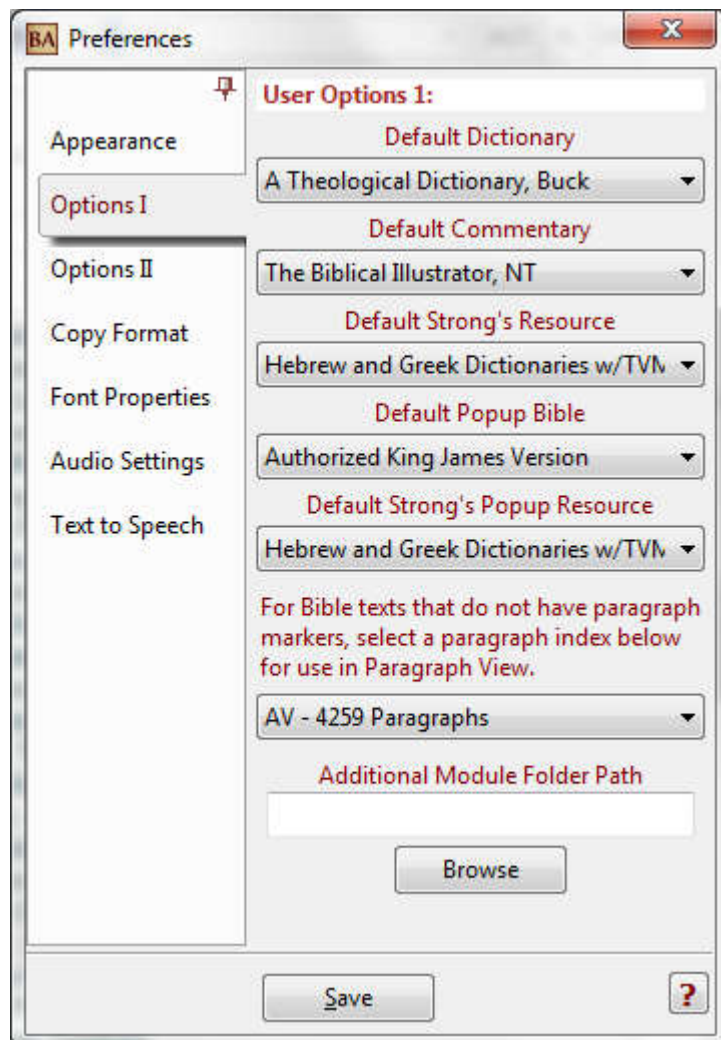
Speech Rate

Move slider to adjust the speech volume or speaking rate.

Skip Reference When Speaking

Check this box to skip Bible references when speaking.

This **Tab** allows the user to change **Bible Analyzer Preferences**.



Default Dictionary

Default Strong's Popup Resource

Select from these lists the default *Dictionary*, *Commentary*, *Strong's*, and *Bible Popup Bible*. These are the texts that will display in the **MultiWindow** (if checked, see below) when the user clicks on a word (*Dictionary*) or reference (*Commentary*) or Strong's Number in the **Bible Panel**.

The popup Bible will be the Bible text that displays when the cursor is over a reference.

The Strong's Popup Resource is the Strong's enhanced dictionary that will display in a popup preview when the cursor is over a Strong's Number

Paragraph Scheme

For Bible texts that do not have paragraph markers (pilcrow), select the paragraph scheme to use to display the Bible in Paragraph View.

To open the **Master Control Panel**, either click the **Tool Bar Button**, select it from the **Control Menu**, or hit **F2** on the keyboard. These actions are toggle actions. Repeating one of them will close the **Master Control Panel**.

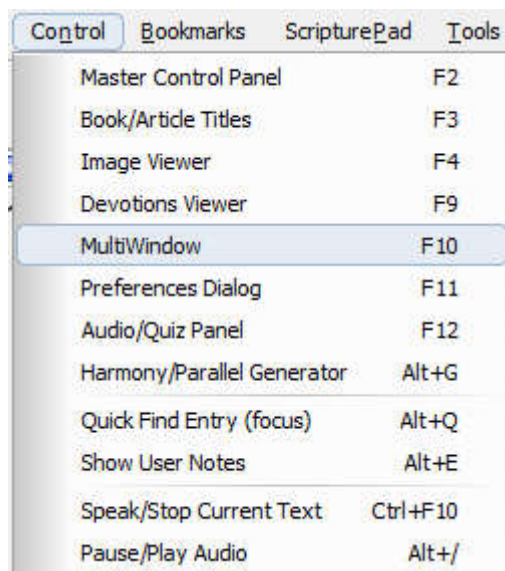
Select a Topic from the menu on the left for help on each **Tab** of the **Master Control Panel**.

The **Master Control Panel** can be resized.

The **Menu** has six main menus,

- **File**
- **View**
- **Control**
- **Bookmarks**
- **Tools**
- **Help**



File Menu

- **Select All on Current Page** **Ctrl+A**

This selects all the text in the panel that has the current focus. To give a panel focus, simply click the mouse somewhere in it.

- **Copy Selected on Current Page** **Ctrl+C**

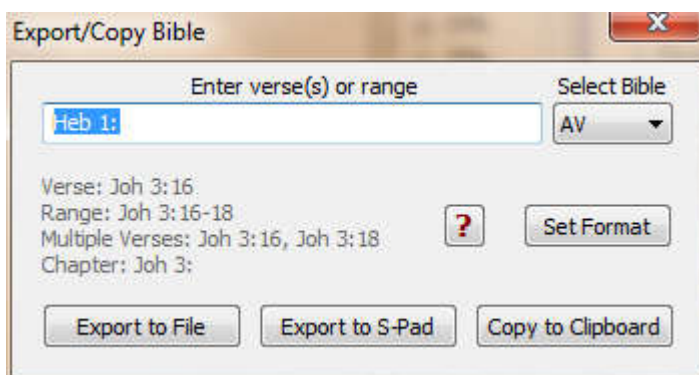
This will copy to the Clipboard any text that has been selected and has the focus. Selection can be made by dragging the cursor over the desired text and highlighting it. It is preferred that the Copy button be used in the respective toolbar.

- **Export/Copy Verses** **Ctrl+E**

Opens a dialog that will export a verse range to *File*, *S-pad*, or *Clipboard*.

Note:

Contiguous and non-contiguous verses and/or verse ranges can be entered separated by a comma. For Example, *Joh 3:16-18, 36, 5:5, Act 2:38, Heb 4:1-6, Phm, Rev 4*, will export all verses chapters and books.



- **Print Current Page** **Ctrl+P**
Print the page with the current focus.

- **Print Preview Current Page** **Alt+Ctrl+P**
Previews the page with the current focus.

- **Exit** **Alt-X**
Closes Bible Analyzer.

View Menu

- **Toolbars**

Allows hiding/showing of the five toolbars.

- **Select/Create Layouts**

Used to select or create a new window layout. This is the same menu as the **L** button on the **MultiButton Control**

- **Expand/Contract Bible** *Alt+B*
 - **Expand/Contract Dictionary** *Alt+D*
 - **Expand/Contract Results** *Alt+S*
 - **Expand/Contract Commentary** *Alt+C*
- These will expand and contract (Toggle) their respective Panel, the same as the *Toolbar Buttons*.

- **Hide/Show Tree Panel** *Alt+T*
- This will hide and show the Bible Tree.

- **Collapse Bible Tree** *Alt+L*
- If several chapter selections have been made in the [Bible Tree](#) many of the *Bible Book Nodes* can be expanded making navigation more tedious. This function will collapse the *Tree* back to it initial state with only the current book expanded.

- **NextVerse** *F6*
- **Previous Verse** *F5*
- **Next Chapter** *F8*
- **PreviousChapter** *F7*

These will function as described, selecting a new reference in the *Bible Window*.

- **Next Verse With User Markup** *Ctrl+F6*
- **Previous Verse With User Markup** *Ctrl+F5*
- **Next Verse With Static Markup** *Alt+F6*
- **Previous Verse With Static Markup** *Alt+F5*

These functions will scroll through the verses with markup

- **Next Book Chapter** *Alt+F6*
- **Previous Book Chapter** *Alt+F5*

These will advance/retreat through the chapters in the *Book/Article Viewer*.

- **Toggle Bible Reference Panel** *Ctrl+R*
- Will Hide/Show the Bible Reference Panel.
- **Increase Window Font Size** *Ctrl++*
 - **Decrease Window Font Size** *Ctrl+-*

Control Menu

- **Master Control Panel** *F2*
- **Book/Article Titles** *F3*

- **Image Viewer** *F4*
- **MultiWindow** *F10*
- **Preferences** *F11*
- **Devotions Viewer** *F9*
- **Audio/Quiz Panel** *F12*
- **Session Manager** *Ctrl+M*

- **Harmony/Parallel Generator** *Alt+G*
- These open their respective viewers or dialogs the same as the *Toolbar Buttons*.

- **Quick Find (focus)** *Alt+Q*
 - **Show User Notes** *Alt+E*
- These set the focus to the appropriate box for quick entry.

- **Highlight Selected Bible Text** *Ctrl+H*
- Will highlight the text the same as the toolbar button.

- **Export Selection Verse range To Scripture Pad Insert**
- When a selection is made in the Bible Panel, starting and ending in any part of a verse, pressing the *Insert* key will export the entire verse range to ScripturePad.

- **Paste References From Clipboard** *Shift+F1*
- Will scan the current clipboard data for verse references and display any found as live links in the MultiWindow.

- **Paste References From Clipboard With Verse Text** *Shift+F2*
- Same as Paste References above but also includes the verse text of reference in the MultiWindow. For references that have verse spans (John 3:16-18), only the initial verse will be listed (John 3:16).

- **Paste Clipboard Text With Linked References** *Shift+F3*
- Pastes the entire clipboard text with the Bible references as live links.

- **Speak/Stop Current Text** *Ctrl+F10*
- **Pause/Play Audio** *Alt+/*

These function as described.

Bookmarks Menu

Up to ten verse bookmarks can be entered under this menu, **Alt+1-10**

Bookmarks can be changed by holding the *Shift* key while selecting a menu item and entering a new verse.

Modules Menu

- **Module Download Manager**

This will open the Download manager for downloading Free and Premium Modules

Tools Menu

- **Export User Notes To File**

Will export User Notes to a file suitable for making them into a Commentary File.

- **Display Primary Modules Folder**

Will open the default Modules Folder in Windows Explorer.

- **Display User Modules Folder**

Will open the User Modules Folder (usually in [My] Documents) in Windows Explorer.

- **Display User Data Folder**

Will open the User Data Folder in Windows Explorer (config.ini, notes.usr, etc).

- **Reset Default Settings and Restart**

Will reset the default settings.

- **Download Purchased Modules**

This dialog will guide the downloading of purchased modules from the Bible Analyzer Store

- **Extract Local Module Archives**

This tool is not normally used except for special purposes

- **Module Creation Tools**

See [Module Creation Tools](#)

Help Menu

- **Show Help**

F1

This open this file (*help.chm*) the same as the *Toolbar Button*.

- **Check for Update**

Checks the server at www.BibleAnalyzer.com for a newer version. If found, the option is given to download the setup file to the desktop.

- **BibleAnalyzer.com Forum**

Opens the default browser to the Bible Analyzer users forum (www.BibleAnalyzer.com/forum).

- **View Welcome Page**

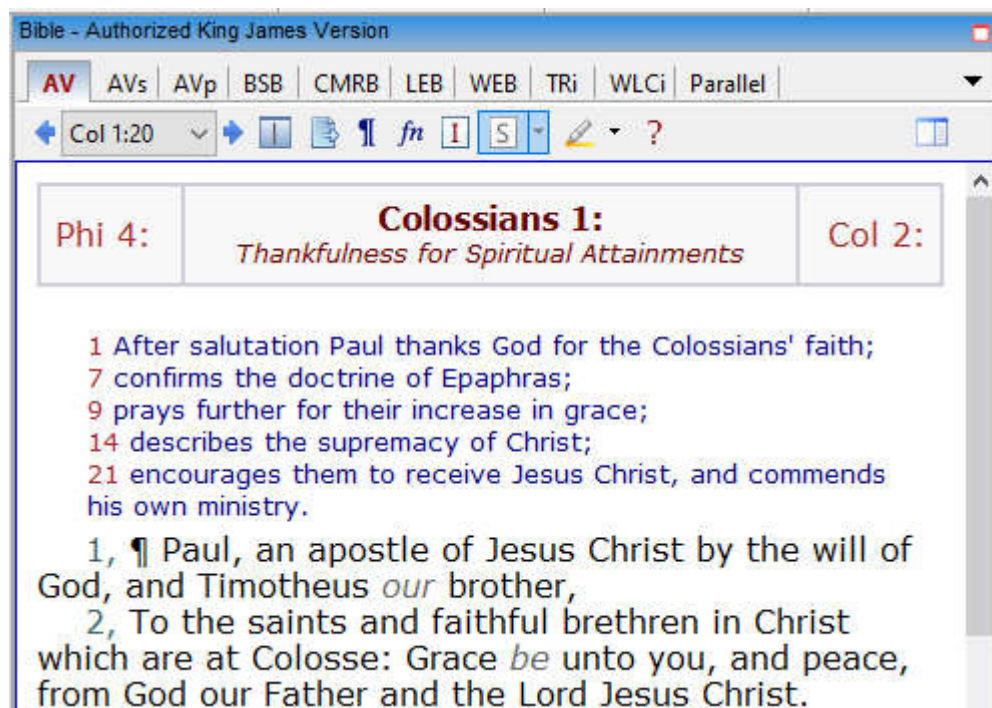
Opens the Welcome Page that is shown on first start.

- **About Bible Analyzer**

Shows the *About Dialog*.

Working With Bible Texts

Once a text is selected from the **Bible Tree**, from clicking a reference in a **Dictionary Text** or **Commentary Text**, or selecting one from the **Verse History List**, it is displayed in the **Bible Panel**.



Bible Display Panel

At the top of the **Bible Window** are **Tabs** representing all of the loaded **Bible Modules**. The *Authorized Version* (AV) is default, but clicking a different **Tab** will result in the current chapter being displayed in that text.

The **Drop-down Arrow** on the right will display a list of all the loaded Bible modules even if some of the **Tabs** are hidden.

The *Toolbar Buttons* on the *Bible Panel* from left to right are:

- **Reference History**

A drop-down list of the last 25 references viewed. Select a reference from the list to again display the passage. The blue arrows will cycle through the list.
(The references are saved on close and restored on the next run of Bible Analyzer.)

- **Dual View**

Will allow two Bible texts (or different sections of the same text) to be viewed independently. When clicked the Master Control Panel will open and the [Dual Texts View](#) Tab will be selected.

For more information see [Dual View](#) under Master Control Panel.

- **Export Bible Page To MultiWindow**

This will export the current page to the MultiWindow where it can be saved for future use.

- **Verse/Paragraph View Toggle**

This will show the Bible text in Paragraph View when on; Verse View when off.

- **Hide/Show Inline Footnotes**

This will show any footnotes in the Bible text inline with the text.

- **Show Interlinear Viewer**

Will show the current chapter in the [Interlinear Viewer](#).

- **Hide/Show Strong's Numbers**

Toggle Strong's Numbers in Bibles so equipped. This button will also control whether Strong's Numbers are visible in exported text and verse popups. This button also includes a dropdown menu that allows selection of various displays of Strong's Numbers associated data. See below for more details.

- **Markup/Highlight Bible Text**

When any Bible text is selected clicking this button will highlight the text with the color selected in the dropdown menu.

- **Quick Help**

Will show a page of the most common functions of the Bible Panel.

- **Hide/Show Cross-Reference Panel**

Toggle Viewing the Cross-Reference Panel

Current Reference

To select a verse, making it the *Current Reference*, simply click on the teal colored verse digit at the beginning and it will be made the current reference marked by a shaded background. The shading color can be changed in [Preferences](#).

Parallel View

The last Tab in the list of Bible modules is always the **Parallel View Tab**. When this tab is selected, the texts of all selected Bibles will be placed in a parallel table with verse alignment. The Bibles displayed in the table can be selected by clicking the *Select Texts* link in the display.

Note:

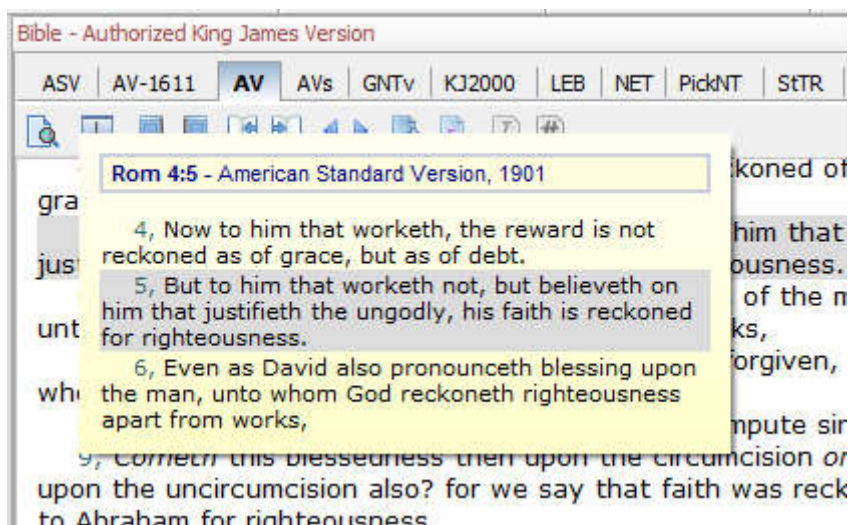
At least one AV class text must be loaded in Parallel View.

Any text visible in *Parallel View* can be searched with the [Right-Click Context Menu](#). When right-clicking on a word or selection a menu item will be generated with the search term to search in the selected Bible. Verses can also be *exported* from a Parallel Text.

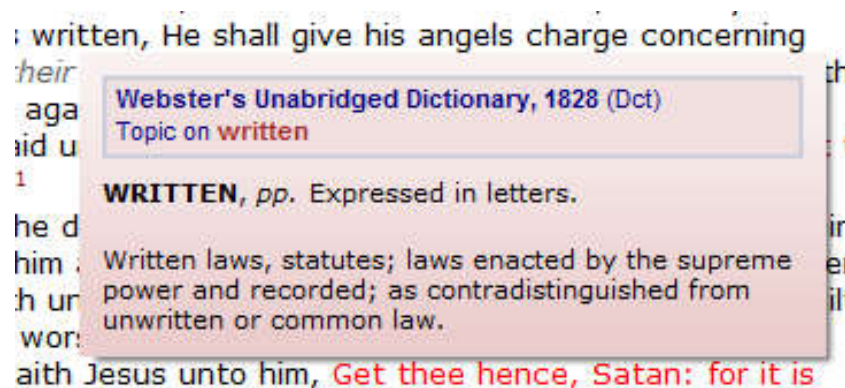
Popup Preview

If the **Ctrl key** is held down and the cursor is placed over a tab name in the **Bible Panel**, a popup will display a three verse preview with the current verse highlighted in the center. In the image below the AV Bible is current and the cursor is over the ASV tab with the **Ctrl key** held down.





Also, If the *Control Key* is pressed while the cursor is over a word in the Bible panel, a popup will display the definition for that word in the default dictionary if a definition is available. Below the cursor is over *written*,



Note:

The Dictionary Popup will work for words on nearly any Bible Analyzer page. Not just a Bible Page.

Click Actions

- A left click on the teal verse number (1,) at the beginning of a verse in the *Bible Window* will by default *search the commentary entries* for that verse comment and *display the default commentary*.
- Left clicking on a word will *search the dictionary topics* for the word and *display the default dictionary and search the commentaries* for that verse comment.
- The actions are the same if the [MultiWindow](#) is used.

Note:

The **Sync** Buttons in the Commentary and Dictionary Windows can be toggled on/off to allow/disallow the corresponding window to update on a Bible reference/word click.

Also, an option to use a double-click instead of a single click to perform the above actions is available in Preferences.

Footnotes

Some Bibles, such as the *Authorized King James Version* that comes with version 4.2 and later, have footnotes (see image above). The footnotes are indicated by small numbers within or at the end of a verse. Placing the cursor over a number will cause the footnote to display in a popup.

With some Bibles, such as the *NET Bible*, footnotes are commentary module based. Clicking the indicator will cause the note to display in the corresponding **Commentary Panel**.

Hint:

Notes over 800 characters will be truncated in the popup to restrict the popup size. Click the number to view the entire note in the **Commentary Panel**

The **Footnote Toggle Button** in the **Bible Panel Toolbar** will *Hide/Show* the footnote indicators. The default state is *Show*.

Bible Window Expanded

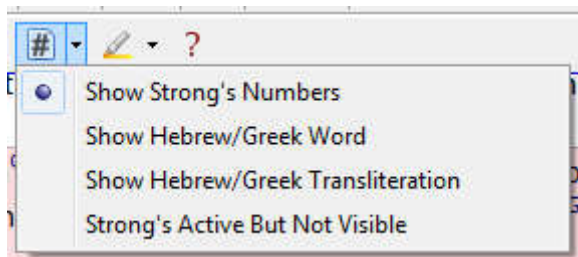
If the Bible Window is expanded (Alt+B), and if the *Use MultiWindow When Bible is Expanded* option is checked, any left clicks will display the results in the MultiWindow, even if the normal *Use MultiWindow* options are unchecked. This allows the user to only use the MultiWindow when the Bible is expanded and the standard windows when not expanded.

Strong's Numbers and Definitions

If you have the *Authorized Version 1769, w/Strong's* (or another Bible with Strong's), and the *Strong's Dictionary of Hebrew and Greek Words* modules loaded (available with the [Bible Analyzer Suite CD-Rom](#)), Strong's numbers will be displayed beside the corresponding word(s).

Placing the cursor over a number will cause a pop-up to be displayed showing *Strong's Definition* for that word. If the number is left-clicked, the definition will be selected in the *Strong's Dictionary* (and other resources that use *Strong's Numbers*) in the **Dictionary Window**.

The Strong's Button has a drop down menu with the following options:



Show Strong's Numbers

Will show the numbers within the Bible text (Only for Bible's which include the Strong's data. Typically Bibles that the tab label ends with 's,' i.e. AVs)

Show Hebrew/Greek Word

Will substitute the original Hebrew or Greek word for the Strong's Number in the display.

Show Hebrew/Greek Transliteration

Will substitute an English transliteration of the original Hebrew or Greek word for the Strong's Number.

Strong's Active But Not Visible

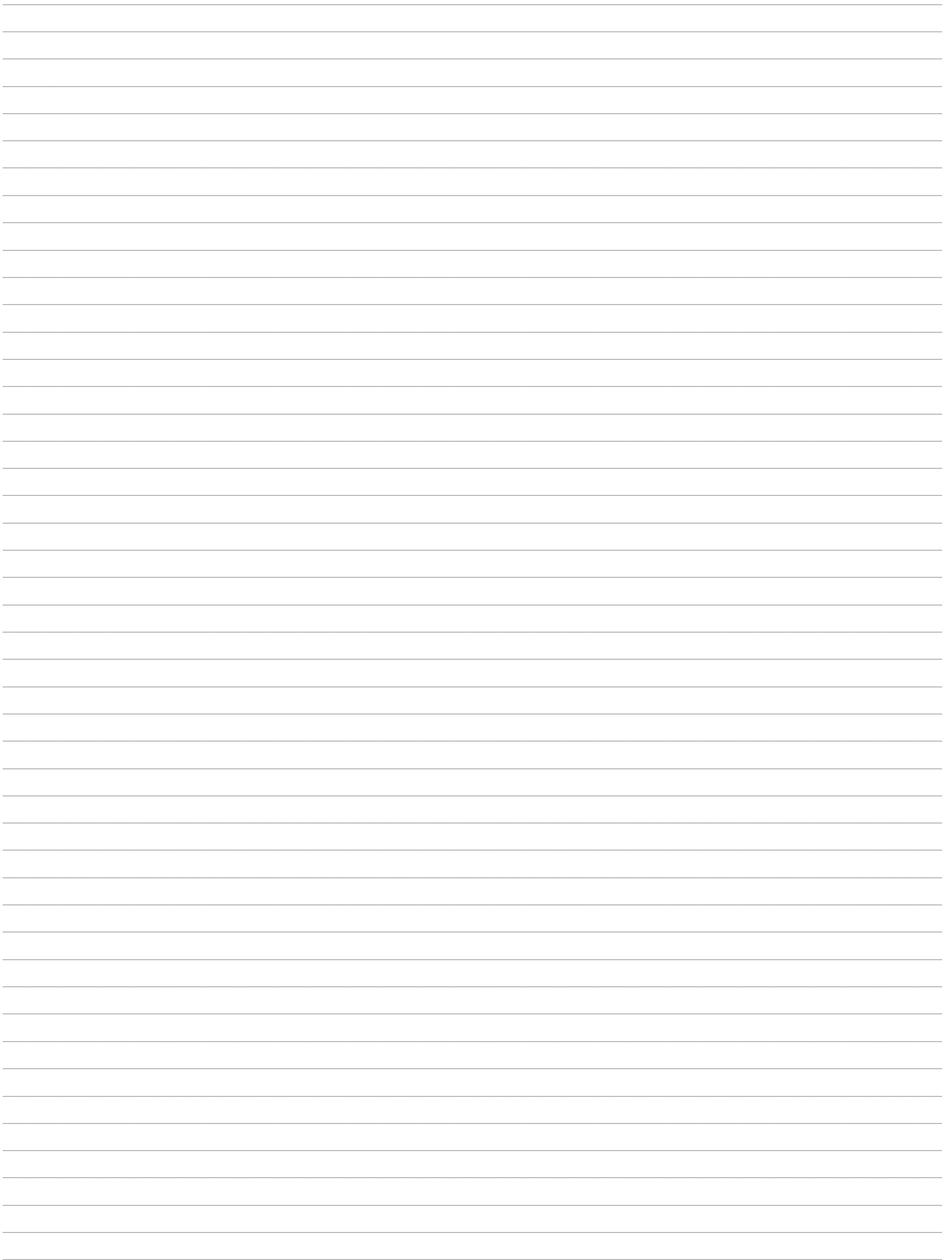
Will not display any Strong's data within the Bible text but will link the data to the associated words. On

mouseover of a word the data will display in a popup (or Quick View Panel) the same as if it was over a visible Strong's Number.

Right-Click Menu

Right-clicking on a reference or word will bring up a menu. See [Right-Click Menu](#) for details.

Right-click on the verse number to have verse options or on a word to have word options. (Viewing the right-click menu with Ctrl key down is not possible)

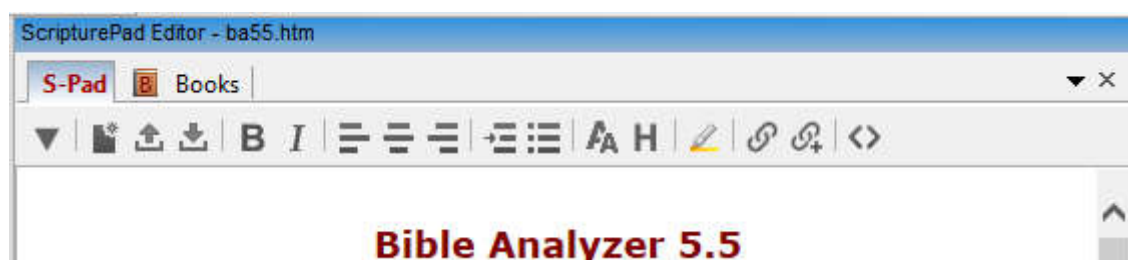


ScripturePad

ScripturePad is an integrated editor that allows the user to prepare *lessons, sermons, or study notes* from within **Bible Analyzer**. **ScripturePad** has the ability to *open, save, and print .xml files* (also .rtf files) and can receive *exported verses or text selections from the right-click menu*.

The first **Tab** of the **Results Panel** is always the **ScripturePad** and is titled **S-Pad**. It cannot be deleted like the other **Results Panel** Tabs.

When **Bible Analyzer** is first started, an initial screen will be displayed showing the *current date and a notable quote*. Press **Ctrl+N** (or use the *ScripturePad* Toolbar/Menu item) to clear the *ScripturePad* display.



ScripturePad can open and save .html, .txt files. Saving in the HTML format is default and will retain text formatting. To open a saved file select *Open File* in the *ScripturePad Menu* or hit **Ctrl+O**. To save select *Save File* in the menu, click the *Save Button* on the **ScripturePad** toolbar, or hit **Ctrl+S**.

Note:

ScripturePad can open the older XML documents (v5.4 and older), but they must be saved as HTML in v5.5 and above to retain formatting.

ScripturePad can print to any installed printer by selecting *Print* from the *ScripturePad Menu*. *Print Preview* is also available in the Menu.

A pencil icon will show up in the Tab of *ScripturePad* if it has unsaved data.

The first Button in the **Toolbar** opens the *ScripturePad Menu* which contains all the editor's formatting tools.

Formatting

Text formatting tools such as *bold, italic, font style, alignment, lists, indention, etc.* are available from the Toolbar, the *ScripturePad Menu* (the down arrow in the Toolbar), and some in the *Right-Click* context menu.

ScripturePad will support *text background highlighting* and *live verse references*. To highlight select the desired text and hit the Highlight button in the toolbar. The highlight color can be changed in the *ScripturePad Menu*.

Linking

To make all references on a page *live*, click the **Link all References in Page** Button. It will attempt to make links of all references on the page. **Ctrl+Click** the button to remove links.

The **Create Link** Button will make a custom link to many Bible Analyzer modules of any selected text. To use,

- Select a range of text
- Click the **Create Link** Button
- Enter the link string in one of the following formats

For a Bible ref,

bible://Joh 3.16 or bible://tab/Joh 3.16

ex. bible://Rom 4.5 or bible://AV/Rom 4.5

The Bible reference book name abbreviation must match the Bible Tree abbreviations, i.e. Gen, Exo, ... Mat, Mar, ... Rev, etc.

For a dictionary topic,

dict://tab/topic

ex. dict://strongex/g25

For a commentary topic,

comm://tab/topic

ex. comm://ovc/jam_5.20

For a book chapter,

book://title/chapter

ex. book://more than forgiven/justification

"Tab" must be the actual tab name of the title.

The topic/chapter must be the exact text of each.

All links will provide a popup preview on mouseover *except the book:// links*.

ScripturePad on Start

There is an option [Preferences](#) to display the last saved *ScripturePad* .xml file on start. This will over ride the quote and image options.

Right-Click Menu Export

Bible verses, verse ranges, and text selections can be directly exported from the other panels and windows into **ScripturePad** through a [Right-Click Menu](#).

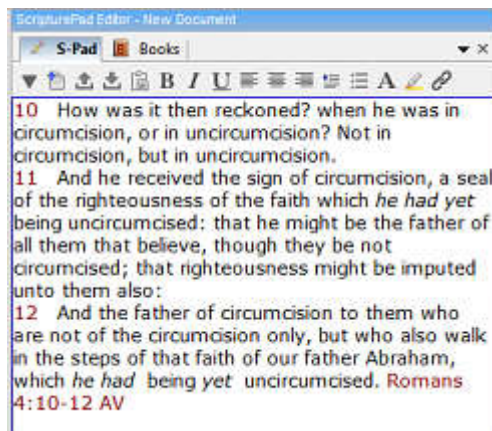
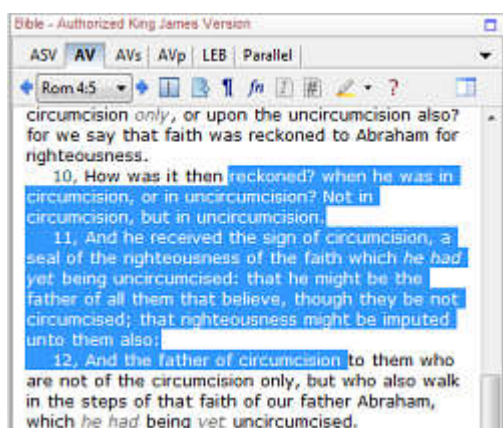
Note:

Exported verses or selections are also copied to the clipboard.

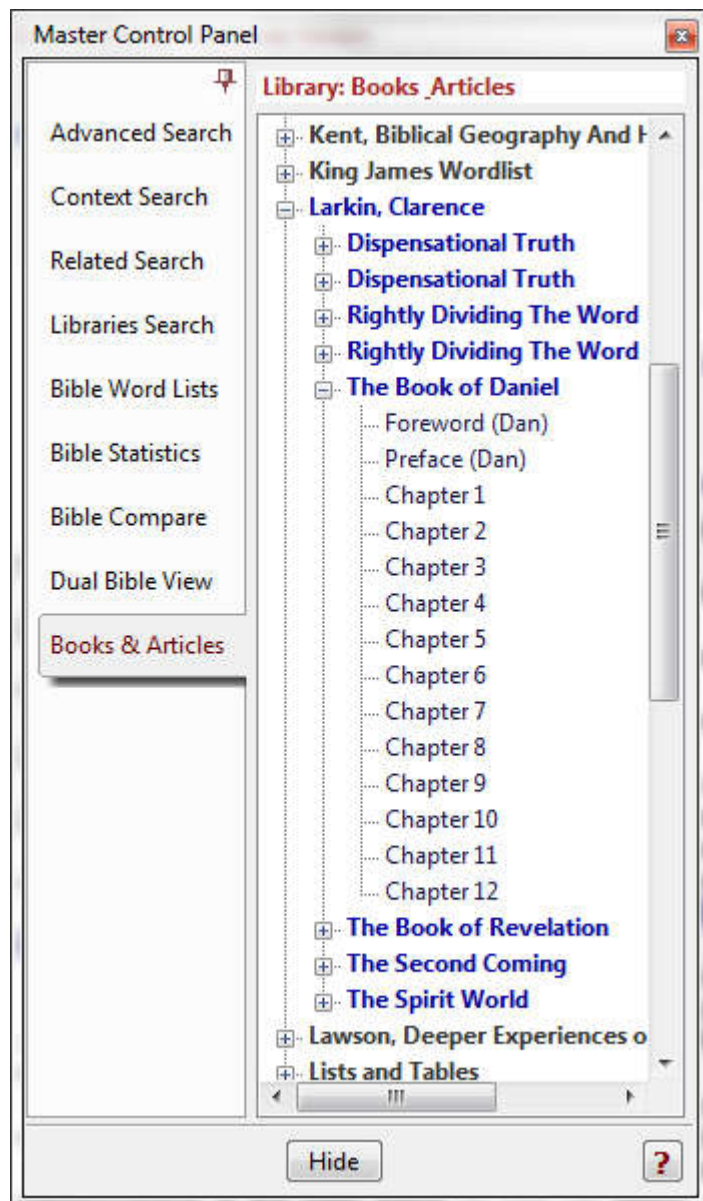
Quick Export

Bible Verses can be exported and formatted very quickly to *ScripturePad* with a single keystroke. Simply select a range of verses with the mouse and then hit the Insert key (Alt+I on Mac). The verses will be formatted according to the settings in Preferences and exported to *ScripturePad*.

It is not important where in the initial and ending verse the selection starts and ends, the entire verse will be exported.



The ninth Tab on the **Master Control Panel** is the **Book/Article Viewer**



The **Book/Article Viewer** displays slightly modified *HTML* files placed in the proper SQLite

database format (.bk extension). See [Module Creation Tools](#) for details on how to create them.

Viewing Texts

To open the **Book Titles List** click the Toolbar Button or press **F3**. The List is under a Tab in the **Master Control Panel**. To view a text select a chapter under the Title. Single chapter book have a *Contents* chapter.

By default the Book Text will display under a dedicated **Books Tab** (the second tab) in the **Results Display**.

Tip:

By changing the option in [Preferences](#), the text can alternatively be displayed in a *stand-alone window*.

If a text contain links to images (i.e. *Dispensational Truth*), click the **Back Button** (arrow) on the Toolbar to return to the page from an image.

Searching Texts

Book/Article Texts can be searched as with Commentaries and Dictionaries. See the [Library Search](#) Tab in [Master Control Panel](#) for details.

The **Bible Analyzer Suite CD-Rom** contains a multitude of valuable texts that total many thousands of pages. To view a resource simply select the book name from the top **Book List**, and if the **Title** contains chapters, they will display in the **Chapter List**.

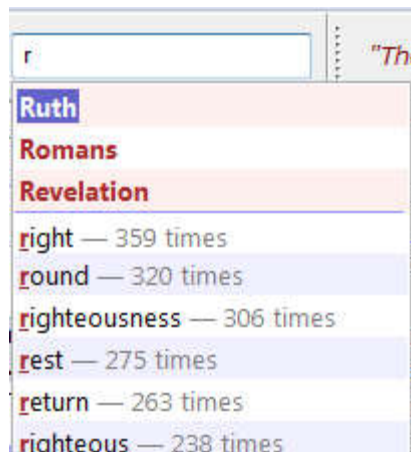

Bible Analyzer has a combination **Quick Find Entry** that allows an entered reference or search results to be displayed.

It is located by default in a Toolbar at the top of the application. Like other toolbars, it can be repositioned.

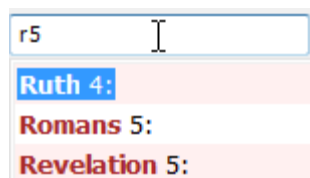


This "smart" single entry box acts as input for both quick Bible searches or Bible reference lookup. It determines the mode by parsing the entered data.

When a character is entered a *Suggestion Menu* will display showing Bible books and words starting with the character. With each added character the display will update.

If the Enter key is pressed the highlighted item will be selected and the appropriate action taken for the selection. If a Bible reference, the reference will be displayed in the Bible Panel. If a Bible word the word will be searched for and the results displayed in the Results panel.

If a digit is entered, even after a single character, the Entry will attempt to match a Bible chapter with books beginning with the letter as seen below.



If a period or colon is placed between digits the *Suggestion Menu* will display the entry as chapter and verse. Thus if r4.5 is entered, 4:5 will be displayed after every Bible book (if valid).

Note:

If the digit surpasses the range of and displayed book, the entry will only display the greatest valid reference, as in Ruth 4: above.

Hint:

If the user does not want to use the *Suggestion Menu*, entering a single space before any character will disable it.

If a digit is entered alone the entry will attempt to display that verse in the current chapter. If digits separated by a period or colon are entered, the *Suggestion Menu* will display that chapter and verse in the current book (if valid).

If non sequential Bible book abbreviations are entered (such as *mt* for *Matthew*), the *Suggestion Menu* will not display, but when the Enter Key is pressed the Entry will attempt to parse the abbreviation and display the entered reference in the Bible Panel.

All entries are retained for later use. Use the *drop-down arrow* to access.

Hint:

For much more comprehensive Bible searching, use [Advanced Bible Search](#) feature in the [Master Control Panel](#).

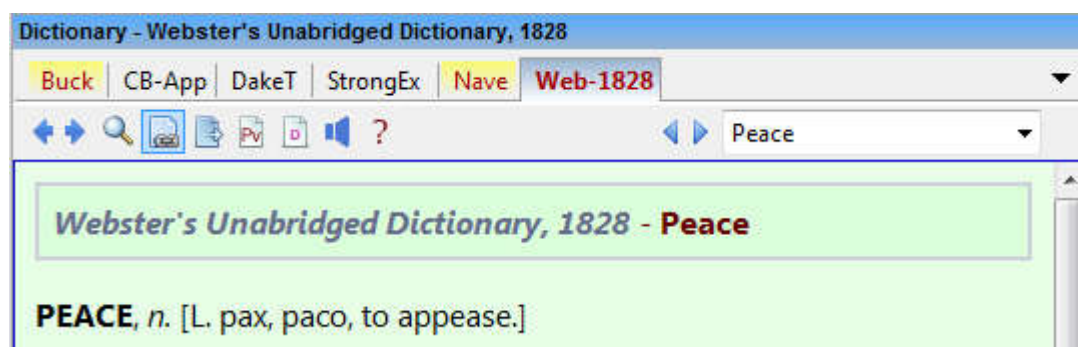
Working With Dictionaries

The **Dictionaries** are navigated by **Tabs** very much like the **Bibles**. To view a specific **Topic** either select a **Topic** from the **Topic List**, or begin typing in the **Topic Entry** and the **Topic List** will scroll with each character. Either **Left-Click** the selection in the **Topic List** or press the **Enter key** and the **Definition** will display.

A Yellow tab highlight is displayed in the **Dictionary Tab(s)** when the selected entry is found in that module. To view the entry, click the **Tab**. The selected **Dictionary** module will show the selected entry.

Note:

*Any of the underlined references in any **Dictionary Panel** will show a pop-up of the verse when the mouse cursor is placed over the reference. Also, a left-click on the reference will cause that verse to be displayed in context in the **Bible Window**.*



The **Drop-down Arrow** will display a list of all the loaded Dictionary modules even if some of the **Tabs** are hidden. (See image below). The titles in **Dark Red** show the current entry is in that title.



The Toolbar Buttons on the Dictionary Panel from left to right are:

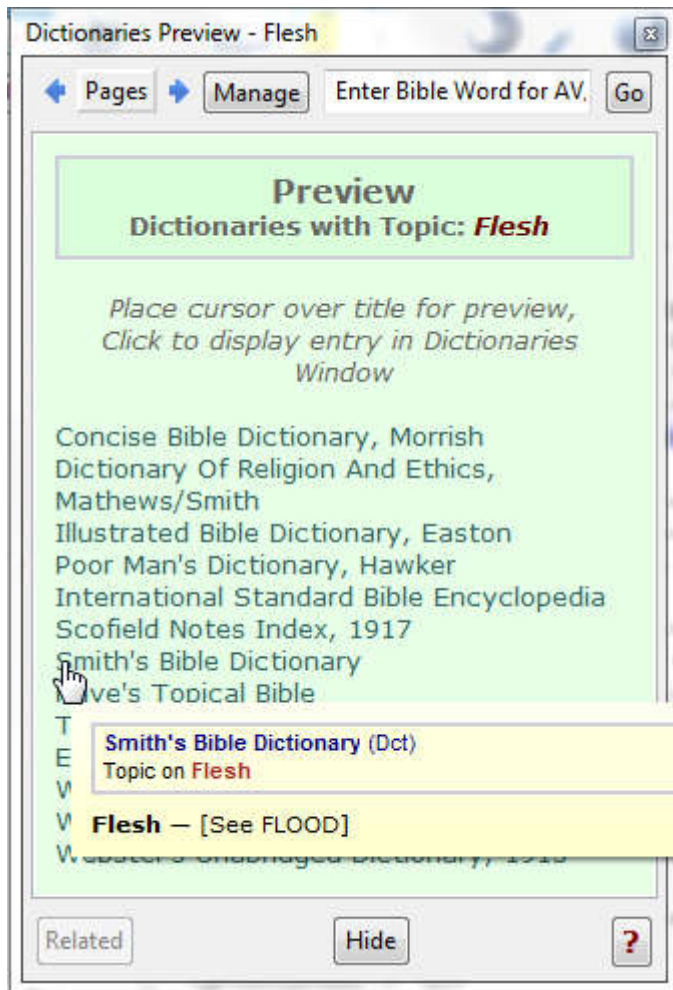
- **History Back**
Go back to previously viewed pages
- **History Forward**
Return Forward to previously viewed pages
- **Search Current Dictionary**
Search the current dictionary in the Library Search tab in Master Control Panel
- **Link to Word (Toggle)**
Allow Left-Click on a word in any Panel to search for Topics in all Dictionaries. Any dictionary with the topic will have a green icon in its tab area, as seen in the image above. The topic will display in Default Dictionary selected in [Preferences](#),

- **Export Page To MultiWindow**

This will export the current page to the MultiWindow where it can be saved for future use.

- **Preview Dictionaries With Topic in MultiWindow**

This will create a page in the MultiWindow with all the dictionaries that have an entry of the current topic. On mouseover each title will show a preview of the entry.



- **Set As Default Dictionary**

Will set the current dictionary as the default Dictionary. It is the same as setting the default dictionary in Preferences.

- **"Read" Page With Text-To-Speech**

Will "read" the page using the system Text-To-Speech engine. See Preferences for options. *If a selection is made it will read the selection only.*

- **Quick Help**

Will show a page of the most common functions of the Dictionary Panel.

- **Previous Topic**

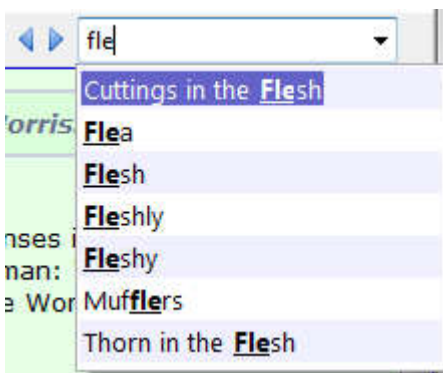
Display the immediately previous Topic in this dictionary

- **Next Topic**

Display the immediately next Topic in this dictionary

- **Topic Entry Filter**

Typing in the entry will filter all the dictionaries topics according to the terms entered. Clicking the dropdown arrow will display all the topics in a list.



View Dictionary Definitions

To view the definition of a word in any of the other Panels (such as the **Bible Panel**) merely Left-Click on a word and its definition from the default dictionary will be displayed. The option is available to view the definition in the [MultiWindow](#) also.

Note:

The definition can optionally be displayed in the main *Dictionary Window* by making a change in [Preferences](#).

Hint:

When a word is left-clicked it will be looked up in the default dictionary. With the **Alt** key down, the word will be looked up in the current dictionary.

Dictionary Modules

According to the modules installed, **Bible Analyzer** will display each of them under its own **Tab heading**. To view the contents of a module click the **Tab** and either

- Select an entry from the **Topics list** on the right
- Begin typing a word in the **Topics Entry Box** above the list (The list will scroll as you type making selection easier)
- Left-Click on a word under any **Bible Window** (left pane)

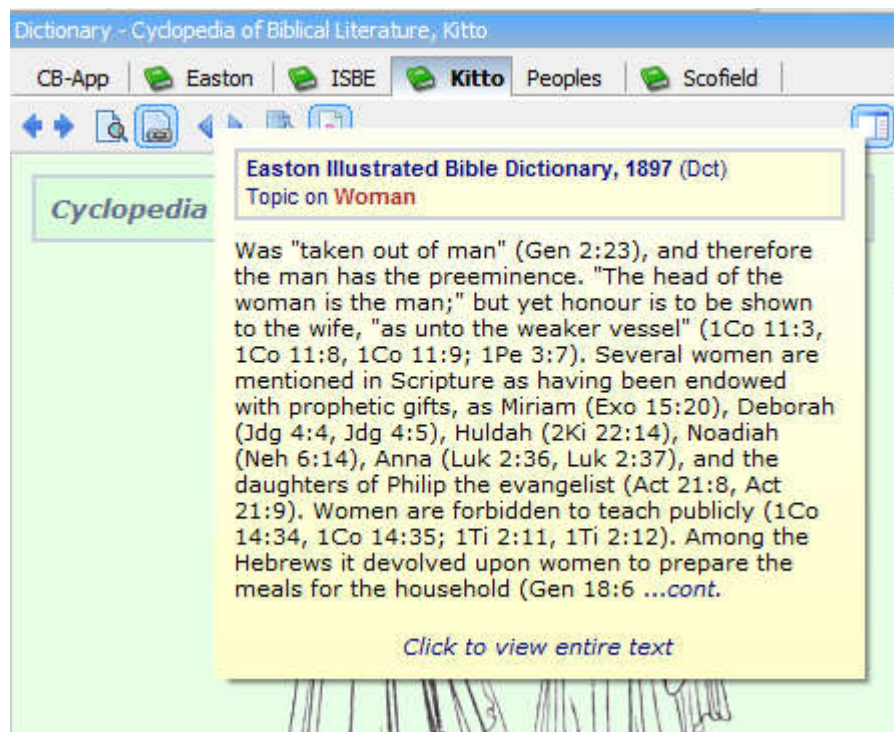
Once your selection is made the contents of the Dictionary module will be displayed.

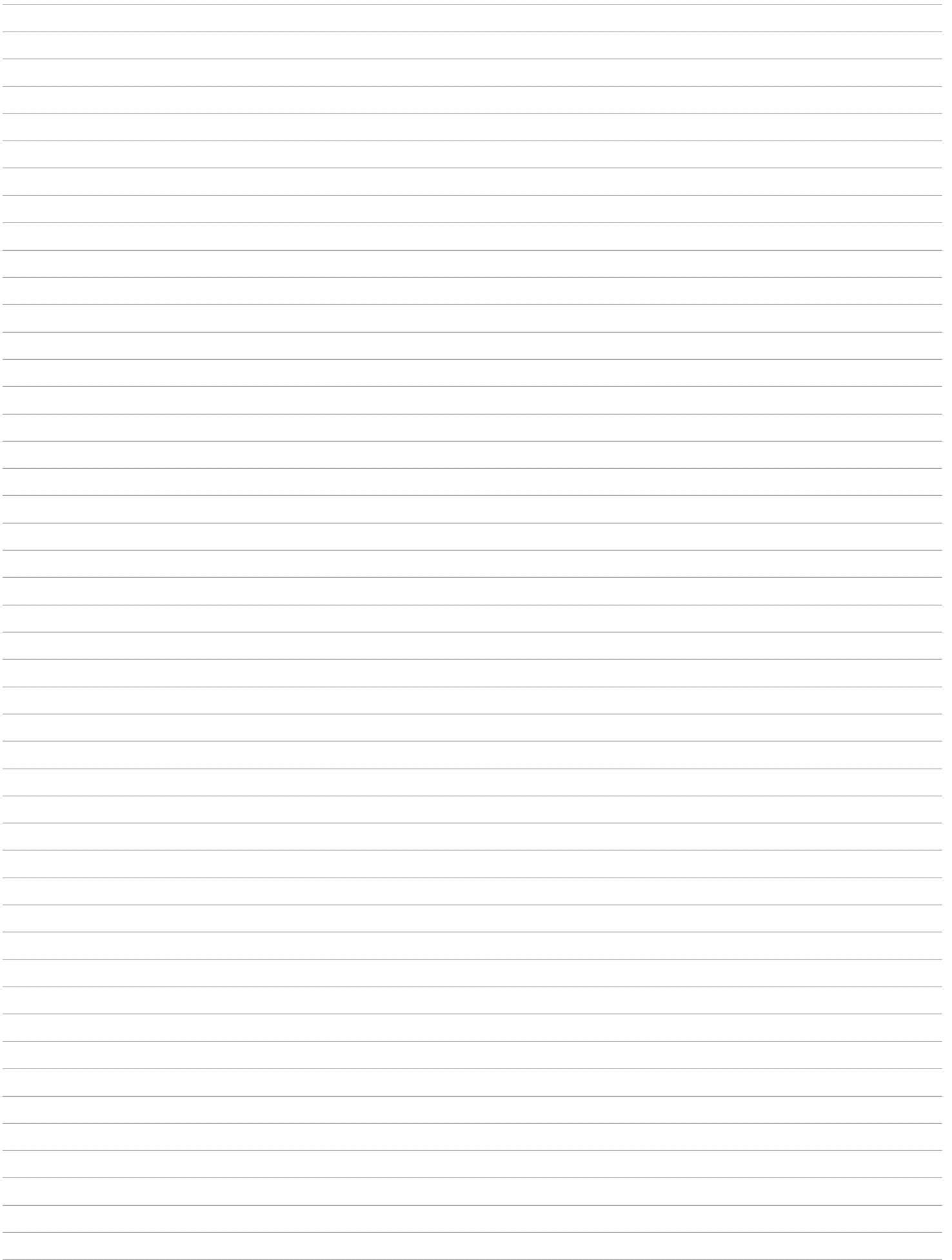
Right-Click Menu

Right-clicking on a reference or word will bring up a menu. See [Right-Click Menu](#) for details.

Popup Preview

If the **Ctrl** key is held down and the cursor is placed over a tab name in the **Dictionary Panel**, a popup will display a preview of the current topic or word. In the image below the Kitto Dictionary is current and the cursor is over the *Easton* tab with the **Ctrl** key held down.





User Notes & Commentary

The first Tab of the Commentary Panel is always the [User Notes & Commentary](#). See that topic for more details

Working With Commentaries

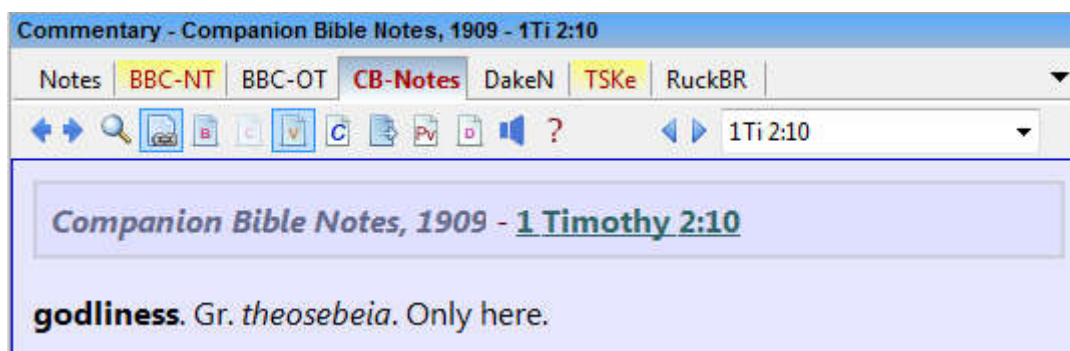
Like the **Dictionaries** and **Bibles**, **Commentaries** are navigated by **Tabs**.

To view a specific **Comment** either select a **Reference** in the **Bible Panel** (If **Link to Reference** is selected) or open the **Verse List** by clicking the **Show/Hide Verse List Button** and select a **Verse** from the **Verse List**, or begin typing a verse in the **Verse Entry**. The **Verse List** will scroll with each character entered. Either **Left-Click** the selection in the **Verse List** or press the **Enter key** and the **Comment** will display.

A Yellow tab highlight is displayed in the **Commentary Tab(s)** when the selected entry is found in that module. To view the entry, click the **Tab**. The selected **Commentary** module will show the selected entry.

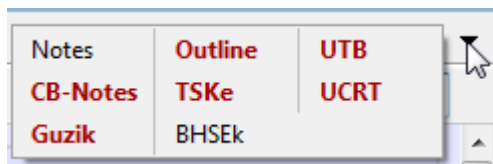
Note:

*Any of the underlined references in any **Commentary Panel** will show a pop-up of the verse when the mouse cursor is placed over the reference. Also, a left-click on the reference will cause that verse to be displayed in context in the **Bible Window**.*



Shown with optional blue background color

The **Drop-down Arrow** will display a list of all the loaded **Commentary** modules even if some of the **Tabs** are hidden (See image below). The titles in **Dark Red** show the current entry is in that title.



The **Toolbar Buttons** on the **Commentary Panel** from left to right are:

- **History Back**
Go back to previously viewed pages
- **History Forward**
Return Forward to previously viewed pages
- **Search Current Commentary**
Search the current commentary in the Library Search tab in Master Control Panel
- **Sync to Reference (Toggle)**
Allow Left-Click on any underlined reference or verse in Bible Panel to update the Commentary Tabs and Display.

Note:

The Commentary Tabs and Display is only updated from a Reference when the Sync to Reference Button is ON. If it is OFF and a reference is clicked in any panel, even in the Commentary Panel itself, the verse will display in context in the Bible Panel, but the Commentary Tabs and Display will not update to reflect the new verse.

- **Show Book Comments**

Show Book comments for current book (if any)

This makes it much easier to browse verse based comments.

- **Show Chapter Comments**

Show Chapter comments for current chapter (if any)

- **Export Page To MultiWindow**

This will export the current page to the MultiWindow where it can be saved for future use.

- **Show Verse Comments**

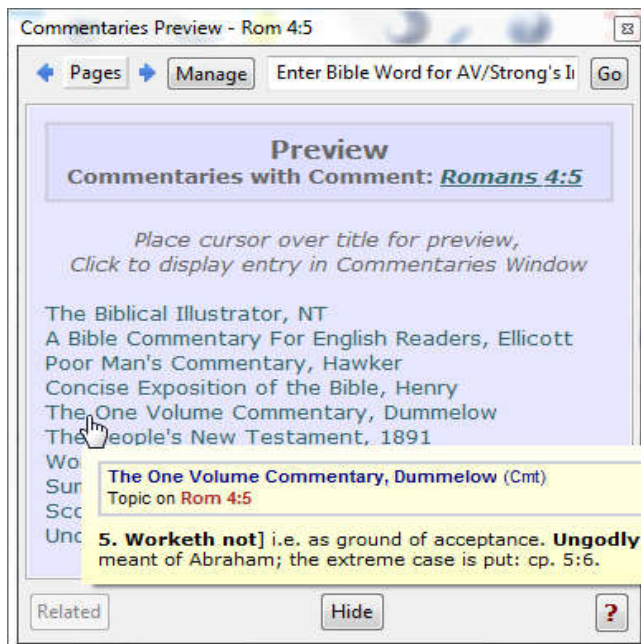
Show Verse comments for current verse (if any)

- **Preview Commentaries With Reference in MultiWindow**

This will create a page in the MultiWindow with all the commentaries that have an entry of the current reference. On mouseover each title will show a preview of the entry.

- **Show All Comments For Chapter**

When ON all the comments for the current chapter will be displayed in a single page while in Verse View.



- **Set As Default Commentary**

Will set the current commentary as the default commentary. It is the same as setting the default commentary in Preferences.

- **"Read" Page With Text-To-Speech**

Will "read" the page from the top using the system Text-To-Speech engine. See Preferences for options. *If a selection is made it will read the selection only.*

- **Quick Help**

Will show a page of the most common functions of the Commentary Panel.

- **Previous Comment**

Display the immediately previous **Comment** in this **Commentary** (may not match the previous verse)

- **Next Topic**

Display the immediately next **Comment** in this **Commentary** (may not match the next verse)

- **Topic Entry Filter**

Typing in the entry will filter all the commentaries references according to the terms entered. Clicking the dropdown arrow will display all the references in the list. The behavior of the Tabs and Modules is much the same as in the Dictionary Window.

Right-Click Menu

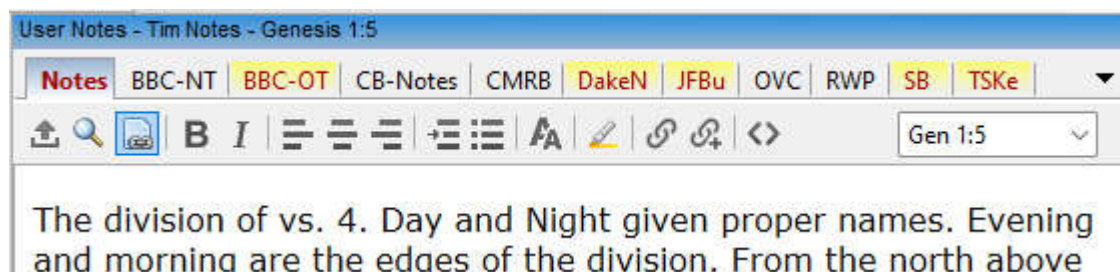
Right-clicking on a reference or word will bring up a menu. See [Right-Click Menu](#) for details.

Popup Preview

If the **Ctrl** key is held down and the cursor is placed over a tab name in the **Commentary Panel**, a popup will display a preview of the current reference. See the [Dictionary Panel](#) topic for more info.

This editor allow the user to add notes and comments synced to any specific *Bible Verse, Chapter, or Book*.

The first **Tab** of the **Commentary Panel** is always the **User Notes & Commentary** and is titled **Notes**.



Notes Usage

To add notes or commentary to a reference, select the verse, chapter, or book desired in the Bible Panel and ensure the reference desired is displayed in the Titlebar Caption (Romans 4:5 in image). Then enter the notes in the editor window. Common text formatting tools such as *bold*, *italic*, *font style*, *alignment*, *etc.* are available.

The input is saved automatically to *notes usr* in the **Bible Analyzer** User folder when another reference is selected or **Bible Analyzer** is closed. To edit or delete any existing note simply edit it in place or delete the text and the updated display will be saved as above.

The **User Notes & Commentary** is flagged like the other commentaries with a Blue-Book Icon (as pictured) when it contains the selected reference.

Sync Button

The *Notes Sync Button* when ON causes the Notes Editor to update whenever the Current Reference is changed. If you would like to change Bible references and remain editing notes under a previous reference, turn the Button OFF. The Editor will remain synced to the reference at hand. Clicking it ON will update it to the Current Reference in the Bible Panel.

Reference Entry

The Reference Entry will display a list of all references that have notes. Selecting an entry will load its notes and make it the Current Notes Reference.

Multiple Notes Sessions

Multiple notes sessions can be created. That is, the user can create completely independent Notes sessions that can be easily switched.

The first button on the Toolbar will allow creation and loading of *Notes Sessions*.

The current *Notes Session* can be searched for a string of text by clicking the *Search Button*.

Exporting Notes

All notes in a session can be exported to a file ready to convert into a Commentary Module. In the Bible Analyzer *Main Menu* select *Tools/Export User Notes To A File* and follow the prompts.

Formatting, Live References, Custom Links

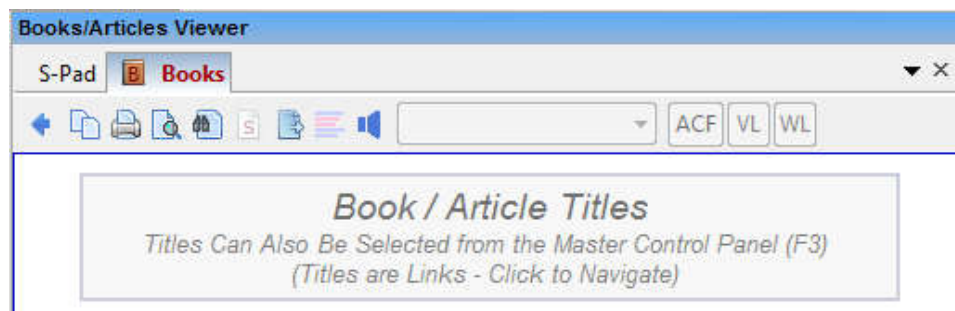
The **Notes Editor** will have basic text formatting features accessed from the Toolbar.

ScripturePad

The first **Tab** of the **Results Panel** is always [ScripturePad](#). See that topic for more details.

Book/Article Display

The second **Tab** is reserved for the [Book/Article Viewer](#).



When the Books Tab is selected, the titles of the available books will be displayed. Each title is a link and clicking it will open the selected book. Navigation can continue through the chapters of the book through links in the header and footer of each page

.Bold titles contain groups of multiple books or volumes.

Hint:

The **Back Button** in the **Results Display Toolbar** will step up to the parent title of each page until the main title page is reached.

The *Book/Article Titles* can also be accessed through a tab on the [Master Control Panel](#).

See that topic for more information.

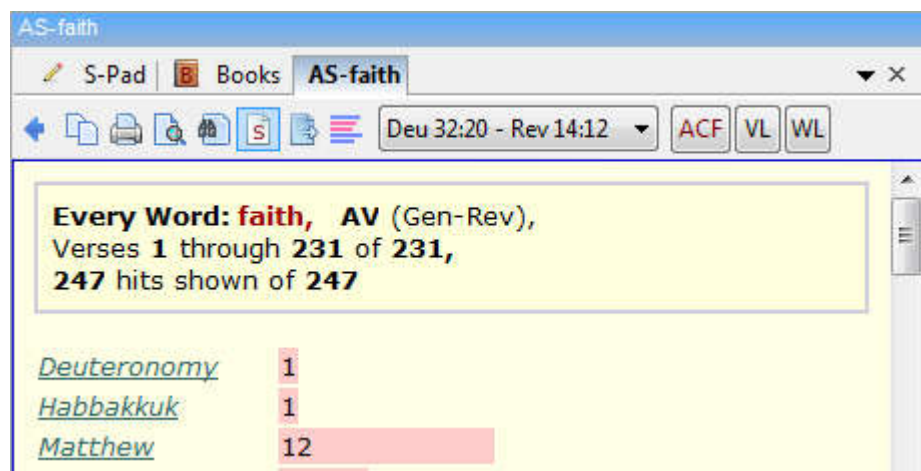
Working With Results

The **Results Tabs** are navigated very much like the other panels. When Bible Analyzer is first started the Results Panel is empty except for *ScripturePad* and the *Books* Tabs. When the user does one of the following,

- **Quick Search**
- **Advanced Search**
- **Proximity Search**
- **Word List Search**
- **Statistics Search**
- **Comparison Search**
- **Dual Bible View**

The results or display is placed under a new **Tab** in the **Results Panel** as shown below.





The text in the **Tab headings** indicates the type of data in the Tab.

- **AS/CS- (word)** = Search Results (AS = Advanced Search; CS = Contextual Search)
- **Stat (ref)** = Bible Statistics
- **Comp (ref)** = Bible Compare
- **List** = Bible Word List
- **Prox** = Proximity Search Results (no suffix)
- **Dual** = Dual Text Viewer (no suffix)

Note:

*The **Proximity Search Results**, and **Dual Text Viewer**, will not add additional Tabs after the initial page. All respective texts or results will display on the same page.*

The **Down Arrow** on the right will open a drop-down list of all the **Tabs** making selection of non-visible Tabs easy.

The **X** will remove the selected **Tab** from the **Results Panel**. **Tabs** can also be deleted with a *left double-click*.

The **Toolbar Buttons** on the **Results Panel** from left to right are:

- **Back Button**

Will return to top of page if one of the Book names was clicked to jump to the first entry.

- **Copy Selected Text**

If any text is selected, it will be copied to the clipboard

- **Print Page**

This will open the printer dialog

- **Print Preview Page**

View the page as it will be if printed

- **Find In Page**

Search the page for a word and update the display with all the hits marked with a blue highlight.

- **Snippet/Single Line Button**

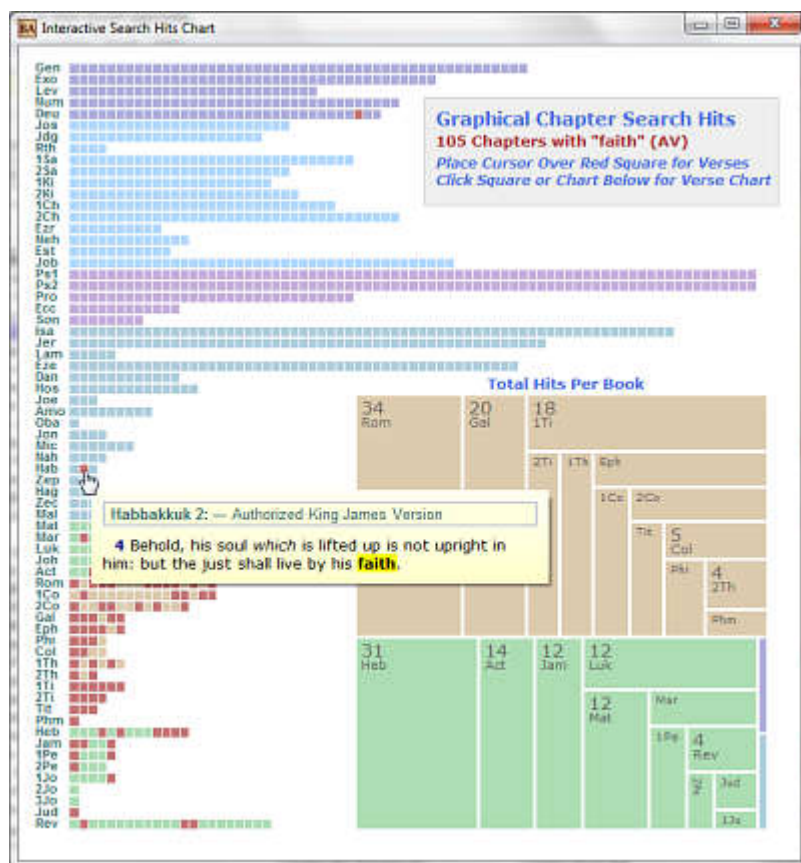
When ON the search results will only show a snippet of the verse with the hit word normally in the center. This will most often have each result on a single line for quick scanning of the verses. When OFF the entire verse will display.

- **Export Page**

Will export or clone the contents of the page to the [MultiWindow](#)

- **View Interactive Chart of Search Results**

When the page is of Advanced Search Results, the option is available to view the results in an interactive graphical chart.



Each square in the chart represents a Bible chapter. A red square represents a chapter that has the current search term in it (here "faith.") On mouseover a popup preview will show all instances of the word in the chapter. Clicking a square will cause the Book charts to display which in turn has verse previews (image below). Clicking the Chapter Chart text will return to the Chapter Chart.

The Total Hits Per Book tree chart is also clickable to go to the corresponding book.



See Preferences for options. *If a selection is made it will read the selection only.*

- **Search Results Range List**

Displays any search results of more than 500 hits in ranges of 500 hits. Select desired range from list to display hits.

- **Advanced Concept Filter Button**

Will open the Advanced Concept Filter Dialog. See Advanced Concept Filter for more details.

- **Verse List Button**

Will display a verse list in the [MultiWindow](#) of all verses in the search results.

- **Word List Button**

Will display a sorted word list in the [MultiWindow](#) of all the words in all verses of the entire search results. The resulting list can be exported to the [Related Search](#) Feature for further searching.

- **"Read" Page With Text-To-Speech**

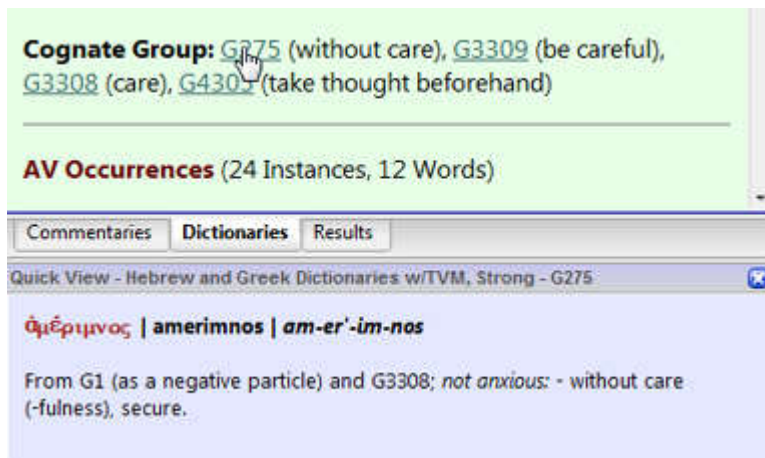
Will "read" the page using the system Text-To-Speech engine.

The *Quick View Panel* is an alternate display area for data that is displayed in a popup window.

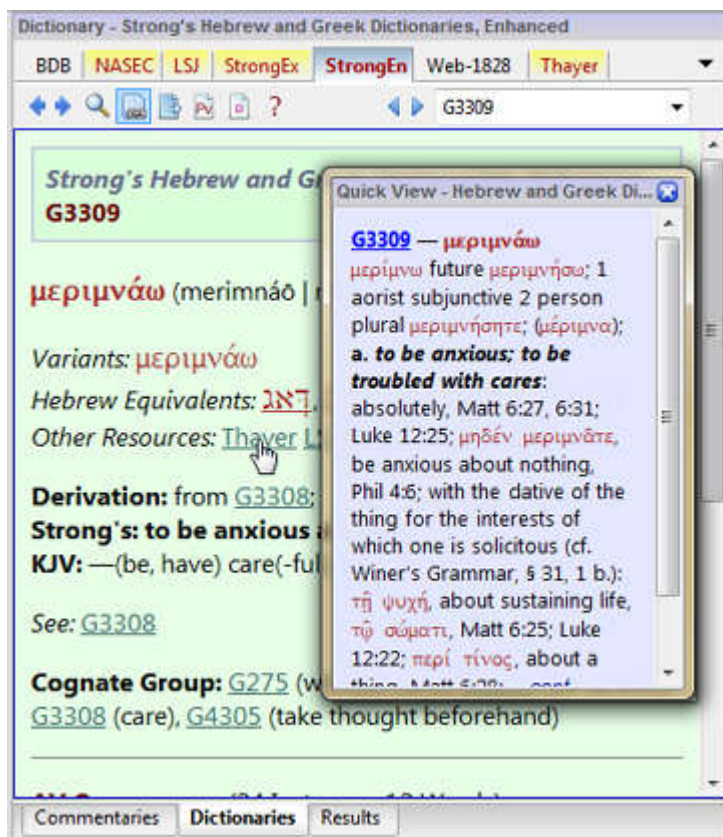
To show/Hide the *Quick View Panel* click the Q button in the *Main Toolbar*,



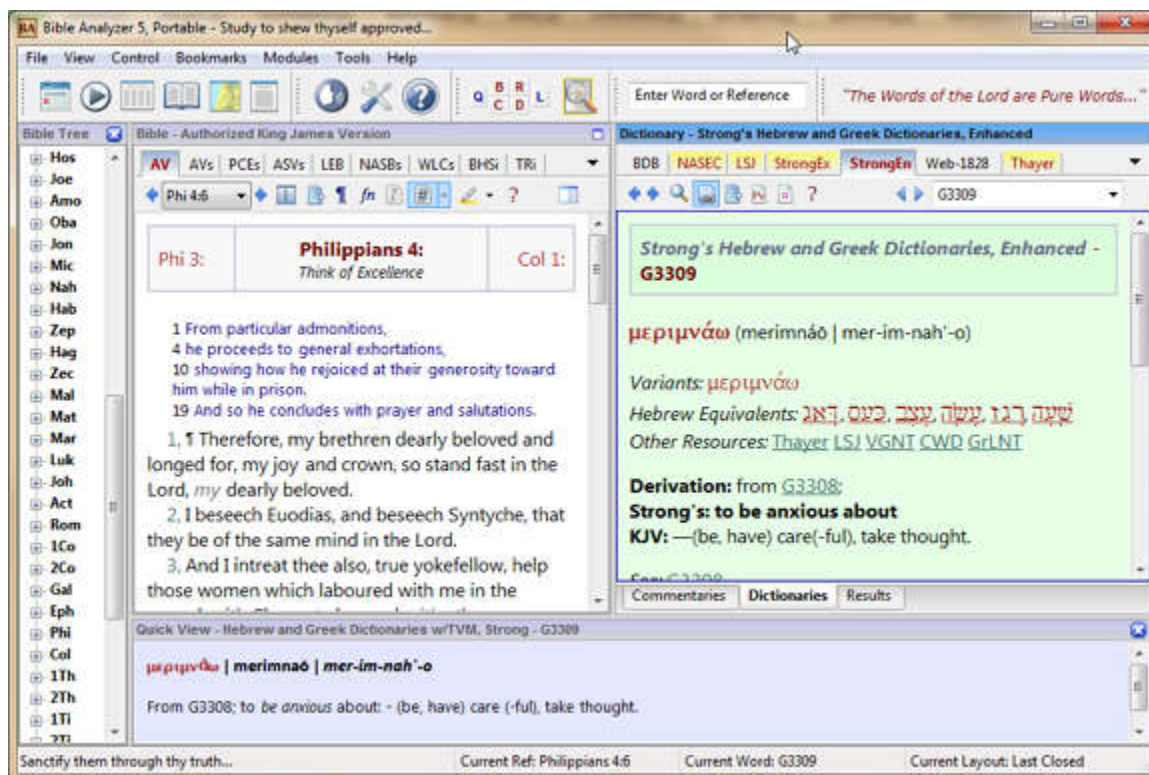
In the image below the cursor is over a Strong's Number link in the Dictionary Window with the data displayed in the *Quick View Panel*.



The Quick View Panel can be moved by clicking and dragging the title bar as any other panel. It can even be floated as seen below.



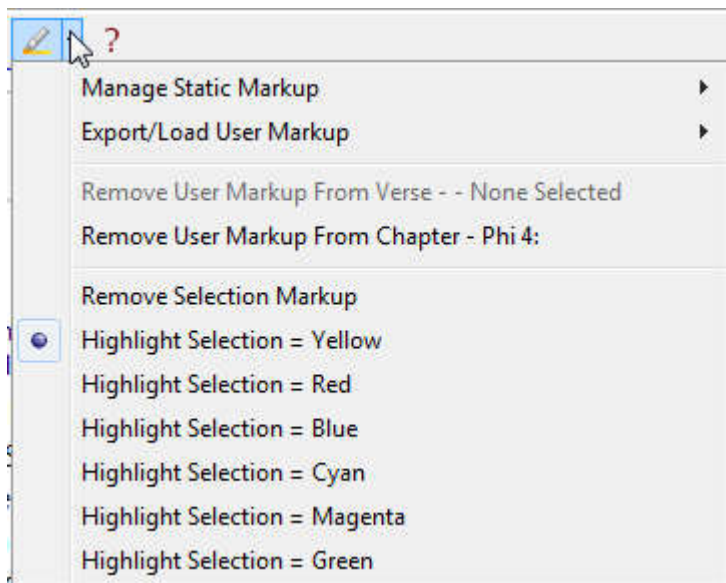
In this image it is docked to the bottom,



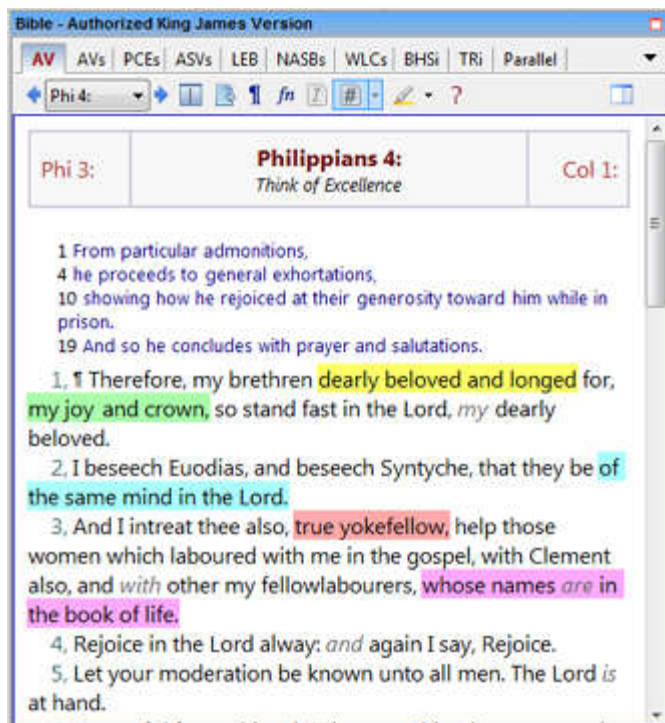
Words can be marked or highlighted with up to six different colors from the *Highlight Button* and Menu. Plus Static Markup features are available.

User Markup

The dropdown menu by the *Highlight Button* in the Bible Panel Toolbar offers six colors to choose from for highlighting.



To highlight, select a color from the menu, select some text in the Bible, then click the Highlight Button in the Toolbar (or press Ctrl+H).



Note:

Highlighting is on a word level. Even if only part of a word is selected, the whole word will be highlighted.

Navigation

The next or previous marked verses can be found by selecting *View/Next Verse With User Markup* or *View/Previous Verse With User Markup* in the *Main Menu*.

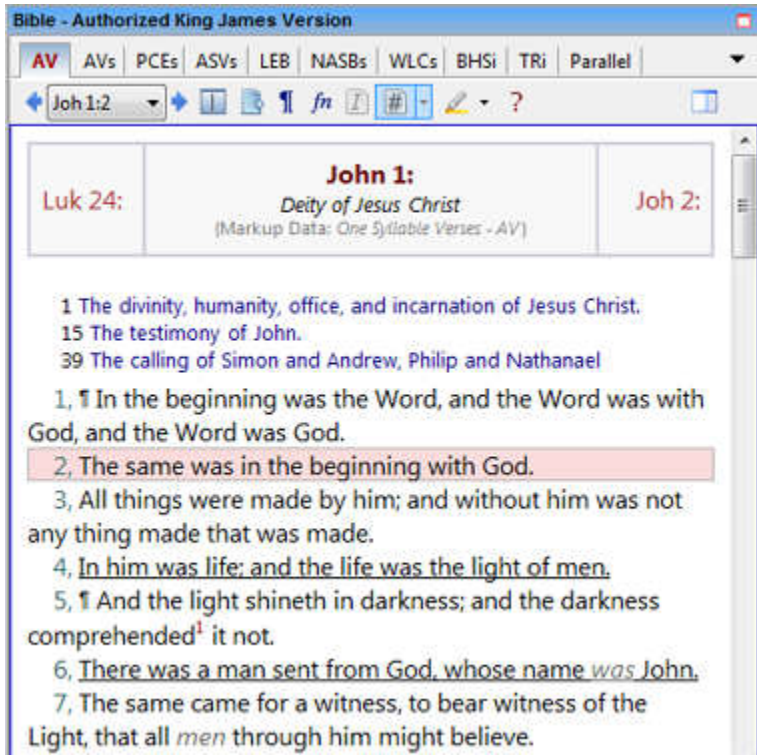
Export/Loading User Markup

User Markup can be exported and reloaded by using the *Export/Load User Markup* items in the Markup Menu. Thus multiple files can be made with different text markup and loaded at any time.

Static Markup

Static Markup is previously made markup data that cannot be directly changed by the user. It is indicated by underlining of the text. The markup data can be made from converted user markup or from properly formatted text files.

A few Static Markup files are included with Bible Analyzer such as The Commandments of Jesus, One Syllable Verses, and Questions Jesus Asked. When one of these filse is loaded into the Bible Panel, Notice will be made in the header while data set is loaded and the verses will be underlined as seen here,



In this image *One Syllable Verses* is loaded with two marked verses visible.

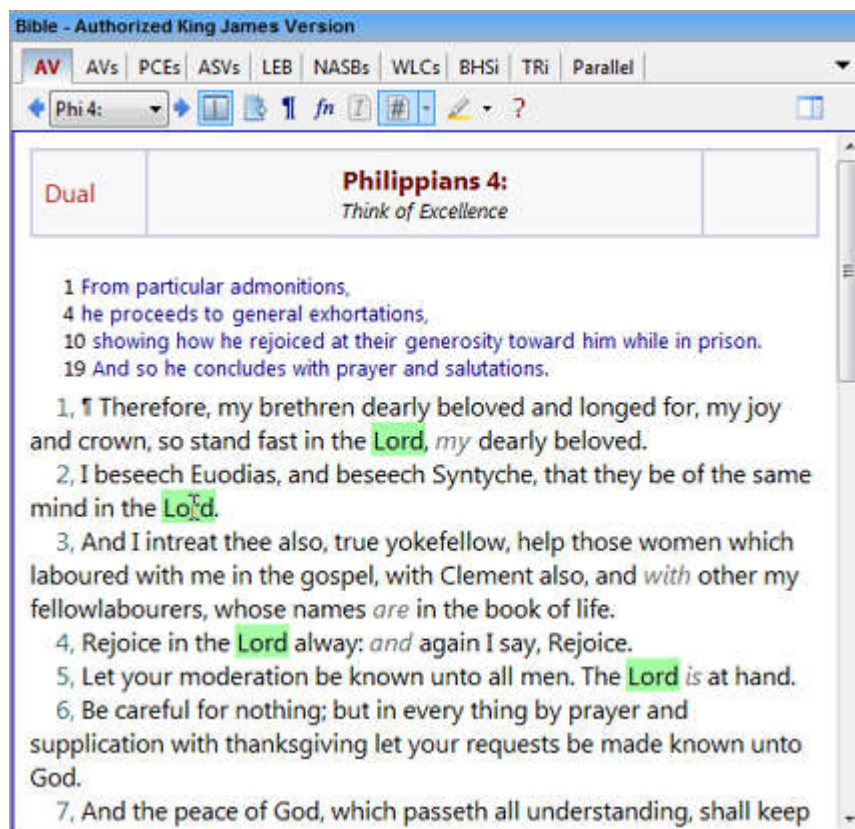
Navigation

The next or previous marked verses can be found by selecting *View/Next Verse With Static Markup* or *View/Previous Verse With Static Markup* in the *Main Menu*.

Matching words and Strong's Numbers (in Strong's enabled Bibles) can be viewed in the Bible Panel and MultiWindow.

Word Indication

All Bibles have the capability of Word Indication. When the Alt key is down and the cursor is placed over a word in the Bible panel, green word highlighting will indicate all matching words in the chapter as in the image below.

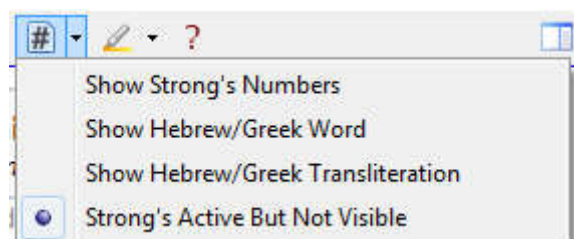


Here the cursor is over Lord, and all instances of Lord are highlighted.

This works for any displayed text, including visible Strong's numbers in any form, such as as numbers, original words or transliterated words.
