<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Getting in</b></p> <p><b>Screen</b> -start a new screen session <b>screen -S</b> -start session with id after S <b>screen -r</b> -attach to running detached session <b>screen -r id</b> -attach to session id <b>screen -ls</b> -list sessions <b>screen -dRR</b> -if session is attached elsewhere it detaches and reattaches, if no session exists it creates on, if multiple exist it attaches to the first <b>C-a ?</b> -displays help once in</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Getting Out</b></p> <p><b>C-a d</b> -detaches session <b>C-a D D</b> - detach and logout <b>exit screen</b> - will exit all the programs in screen <b>C -a C \</b> - force exit</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Escape Key</b></p> <p>All screen commands are prefixed by an escape key, by default C-a (that's Control-a, sometimes written ^A). To send a literal C-a to the programs in screen, use C - a a.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Window Management</b></p> <p><b>C-a c</b> - creates a new window <b>C-a C-a</b> - change to last visited <b>C-a #</b> - goto window 0-9 <b>C-a n</b> - goto next window <b>C-a p</b> - goto previous window <b>C-a “</b> - see window list <b>C-a w</b> - show winbar <b>C-a k</b> - kill current window <b>C-a A</b> - rename current window</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Split Screen</b></p> <p><b>C-a S</b> - split screen <b>C-a tab</b> - switch display region <b>C-a X</b> - close current display region <b>C-a Q</b> - remove all regions but current</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Misc</b></p> <p><b>C-a C-l</b> - redraw window <b>C-a [</b> -view scrollbar buffer <b>C-a [ &lt;space&gt; + nav</b> - copy mode <b>C-a ]</b> -paste  <b>C-a M</b> - monitor window for activity <b>C-a _</b> -monitor window for inactivity <b>C-a C-v</b> - enter digraph <b>C-a x</b> - lock screen <b>C-a :</b> - enter screen cmd</p>
